This provider notice rescinds and replaces PN 13-109

Dear Provider:

Effective for dates of service on and after January 1, 2014, the Medicaid Program of the Health Care Authority (agency) will pay for hemophilia and von Willebrand-related products a fee-for-service (FFS) basis for all Medicaid clients, including those enrolled in an agency-contracted managed care organization (MCO).

These products will no longer be a covered benefit under the client's MCO. All claims for reimbursement of hemophilia and von Willebrand-related products must be submitted as a fee-for-service (FFS) claim.

Note: The agency pays for hemophilia and von Willebrand-related products only when they are provided by a qualified hemophilia treatment center of excellence (COE) and administered in the home. See WAC [182-531-1625\(1\)](#).

To help with this transition, specialty pharmacy providers may request authorization to continue to dispense hemophilia and von Willebrand-related products to clients through March 1, 2014.

To request authorization, contact the agency's Pharmacy Authorization Section at 800-562-3022 extension 15483. If a client has not yet established a care relationship with a qualified hemophilia treatment COE as of March 1, 2014, but an initial appointment for the client is scheduled, specialty pharmacy providers may contact the agency's Pharmacy Authorization Section and request an extension.

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
