Do **NOT** use for expedited rule making

Agency: Health Care Authority, Washington Apple Health

Subject of possible rule making:

WAC 182-504-0130, Washington Apple Health – Continued Coverage Pending an Appeal

Statutes authorizing the agency to adopt rules on this subject: RCW 41.05.021, 41.05.160; 42 CFR § 431.220

Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish:

The agency plans to amend the rule to make it consistent with the wording in WAC 182-504-0135 and to clarify that continued coverage continues until an order is issued by the Office of Administrative Hearings.
