Statutes authorizing the agency to adopt rules on this subject: RCW 41.05.021, 41.05.160

Reasons why rules on this subject may be needed and what they might accomplish:

The agency is amending the Washington Apple Health definition for "agency designee" to include any state agency selected to act on behalf of the Health Care Authority. The agency is also amending the definition of "agency" to include the term "medicaid agency." During the course of this review, the agency may identify additional changes that are required in order to improve clarity or update policy.

The agency filed a similar CR 101 (WSR 15-17-127) on August 19, 2015; however, the notice cited an incorrect WAC number.
