Because of differences in indications, spectrum of activity, adverse reactions and drug-drug interactions, the generic formulations of azithromycin, clarithromycin, and erythromycin must be preferred on the Washington Preferred Drug List. Macrolides cannot be subject to therapeutic interchange in the Washington preferred drug list for the treatment of conditions listed above.
