The Washington State Health Care Authority (HCA) is hosting a technology career fair to staff a new Enterprise Data Management and Analytics (EDMA) office.

What is HCA?

HCA is a state agency that purchases health care for more than 2 million Washington residents through two programs—Washington Apple Health (Medicaid) and the Public Employees Benefits Board (PEBB) Program. We work with partners to help ensure Washingtonians have access to better health and better care at a lower cost. We use a lot of data.

What is EDMA?

The EDMA office is a new group within HCA that helps manage and oversee agency decision-making based on data. The need for HCA's data is growing rapidly. Through the EDMA office, HCA is building the framework to ensure HCA can meet this growing need, ensure the accuracy and integrity of program data, and provide consistent reporting internally and externally. Work within the EDMA office will include:

- Implementing the long-term decision-support roadmap.
- Procuring and implementing tools and training to meet long-term goals.
- Expanding HCA's data platform to support current and future analytics and reporting.
- Developing and overseeing guiding principles, policies, procedures, data management and reporting tools to help HCA analysts and data engineers use data appropriately and consistently.
- Supporting data-driven decision making by providing the right information to the right people at the right time.
- Improving, transforming, and increasing information sharing, accountability, and transparency in data management.

What does the technology career fair offer?

This event will showcase the innovative, challenging, and rewarding work of EDMA, and the skillsets we're looking for. It also provides job seekers an opportunity to:
