Are you taking an ongoing prescription drug? You may be able to save money by visiting a Choice90 network pharmacy, where you can purchase a 90-day supply of your medication. Some Choice90 pharmacies include Bartell, Costco, Fred Meyer, Haggen, Safeway, Savon, and Target.

2017 premiums

UMP Classic premiums for Medicare retirees are increasing to \$278 per month for a subscriber only, up from \$268 per month in 2016.

You'll receive a customized letter from the PEBB Program in late October with information about plans you are eligible for in 2017, including premiums and costs.

Improved benefit: No coinsurance for male sterilization procedures

Beginning in 2017, UMP Classic will offer male sterilization procedures at \$0 cost share to members. You don't pay the medical deductible or coinsurance when you see a preferred provider.
