



Protective gloves are available for your Apple Health provider

Did you know you must have protective gloves available for your provider to use?

For you and your provider to be safe, protective gloves should be worn by your caregiver when they are helping you with hands-on personal care tasks.

Protective gloves can be purchased using your Apple Health (Medicaid) coverage.

- You must get a prescription from a medical provider to order gloves.
- You may receive up to 200 gloves per month.
- Additional gloves may be requested when medically necessary.

For those receiving Apple Health coverage with a managed care plan
