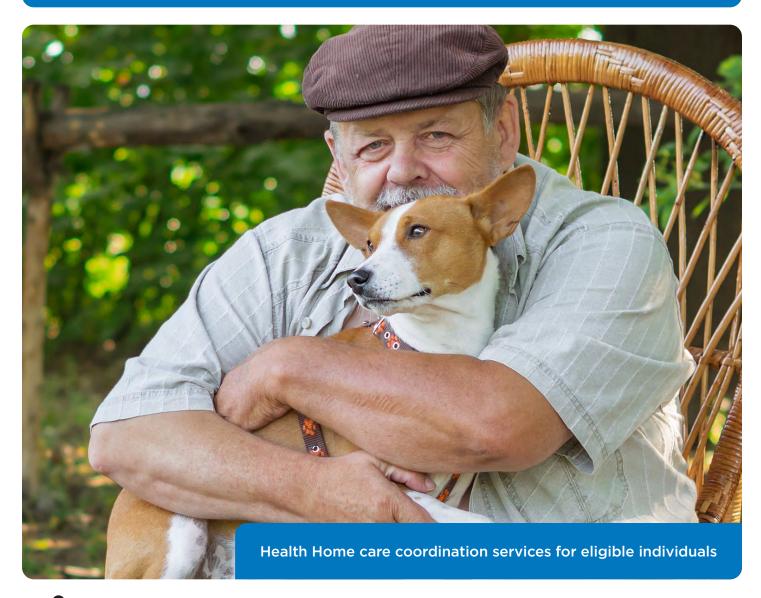

What is a Health Home?

A Health Home is not a place; it is a set of care coordination services. These are provided by a care coordinator who will help you make the best use of the services and supports you currently receive.

Health Home services are designed to support you with your ongoing chronic conditions and help you meet the health goals you select. Health Home services improve coordination of both medical and social service needs, such as long-term services and supports, and behavioral health including substance use disorders. The Health Home program is meant to increase access to and coordination of your care.



What are Health Home services and how can they help you?

- Comprehensive care management includes development of a personalized Health Action Plan with goals and steps to achieve those goals.
- Care coordination helps improve communication with your providers, family, and other caregivers.
- Transition planning helps when you leave a hospital or care facility.
- Individual and family support services identify the roles of family members, informal supports, and caregivers to help you to reach your health goals.
- Referral to community and social support services helps with things like transportation, food, and housing.
- Health promotion provides education and wellness coaching to help you reach your health goals.

Who is eligible for Health Home services?

You have received this Health Home Booklet because you are eligible for the program. The services are for individuals of any age living with at least one qualifying chronic condition. Some chronic health conditions that make someone eligible include:

- Cancer
- Chronic respiratory conditions
- Dementia or Alzheimer's disease
- Diabetes
- Gastrointestinal disease
- Heart disease
- Intellectual disability or disease
- Behavioral health condition
- Musculoskeletal conditions
- Neurological disease

What is a Health Home care coordinator?

A Health Home care coordinator is someone who can help you participate in the Health Home program. Your care coordinator will work with you to receive the right care, from the right provider, at the right time and place.

Your care coordinator will contact you to describe care coordination services and answer any questions you have about the Health Home program.

How do you get Health Home services?

There are three basic steps to joining the Health Home program:

1. Be assigned to a Health Home: Once you are eligible, you will be connected to a Health Home lead organization, who will assign a care coordinator to contact you. The care coordinator will answer your questions and you can decide whether or not to participate in the Health Home program.

2. Complete an Information Sharing and

Consent Form: The care coordinator will help you complete a Health Home services consent form to allow sharing of your medical and social service information. The information will only be shared with providers and others you choose.

- **3. Complete a Health Action Plan:** You will be able to choose your own health goals, which your care coordinator will include in your Health Action Plan. This will be used to help you and your care coordinator see if you need additional services and resources, such as:
- Health care needs
- Long term services and supports
- Behavioral health services
- Community resources
 - Housing
 - Transportation

You can request and arrange future visits at any time, in a setting of your choice.

Do you get to stay with your current health care and other providers?

Yes, your current services and providers will remain the same. As part of Health Home services, your care coordinator may be in contact with providers about coordinated coverage and transitions in care as your needs change.

How will providers know if you are in the Health Home program and who to contact?

They can tell by checking ProviderOne, or by contacting the Health Care Authority at 1-800-562-3022.

Do you have to pay for Health Home services?

No, these services are provided at no cost to you.

What if you are unhappy with your care coordinator?

You can contact your Health Home care coordination organization to request another care coordinator.

What if you move to another area of the state?

You may be assigned a new care coordinator. You'll be contacted about ongoing services.

What if you lose Apple Health (Medicaid) or Medicare coverage?

If you lose Apple Health (Medicaid) eligibility, you will no longer be eligible for Health Home services.

If you lose your Medicare eligibility and not your Apple Health eligibility, you may still be eligible to receive Health Home services.

What are your complaint and appeal rights?

You keep your current Apple Health and Medicare grievance and appeal rights.

What if you no longer want to participate in the Health Home program?

You can talk with your Health Home care coordinator and ask to be taken out of the program. If you change your mind at a later time, you can call the Health Care Authority at 1-800-562-3022 and ask to be reenrolled with the Health Home program.

For American Indians or Alaska Natives

Eligible American Indians and Alaska Natives can choose to participate in a Health Home at any time by contacting the Health Care Authority, who will verify eligibility and assist with enrollment.
