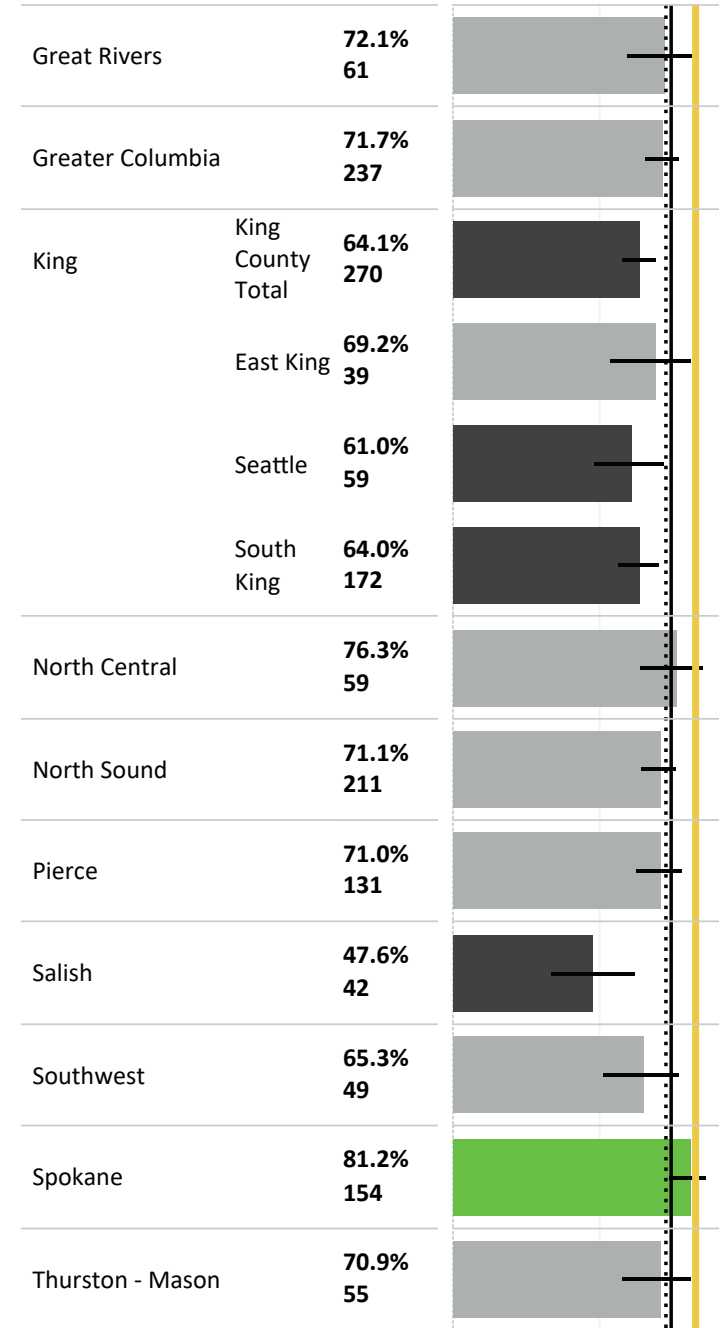

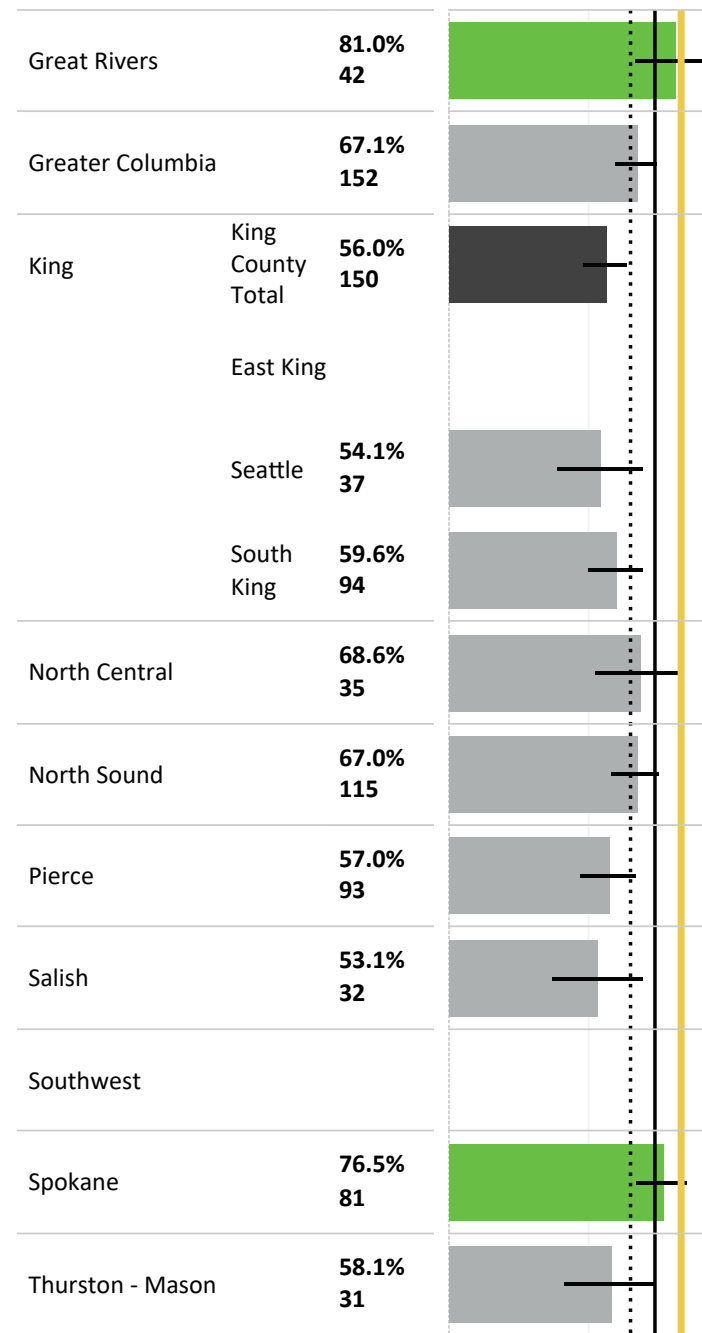
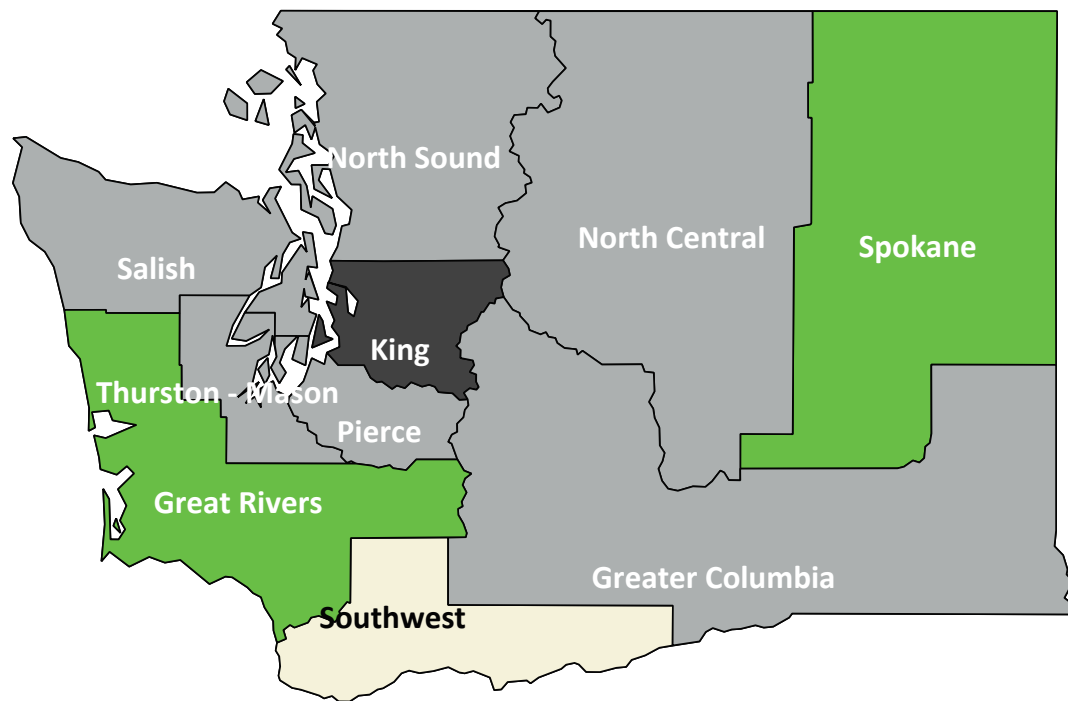

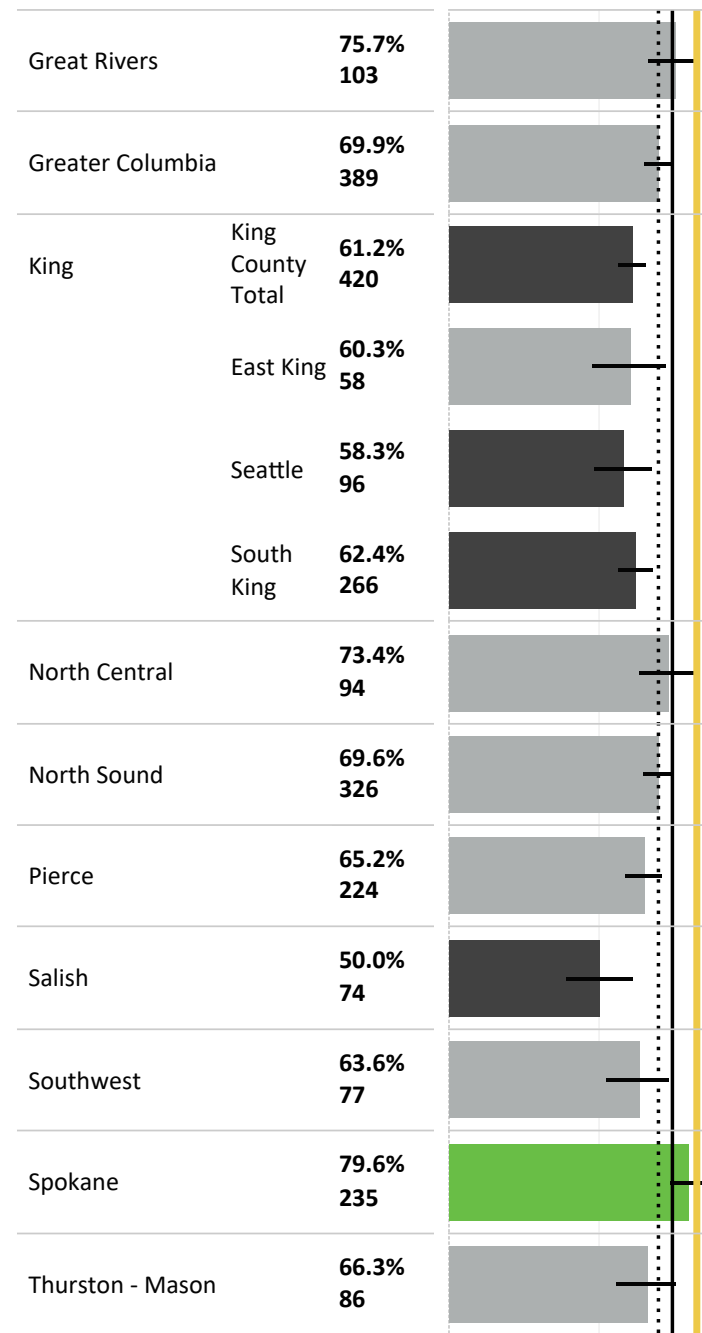
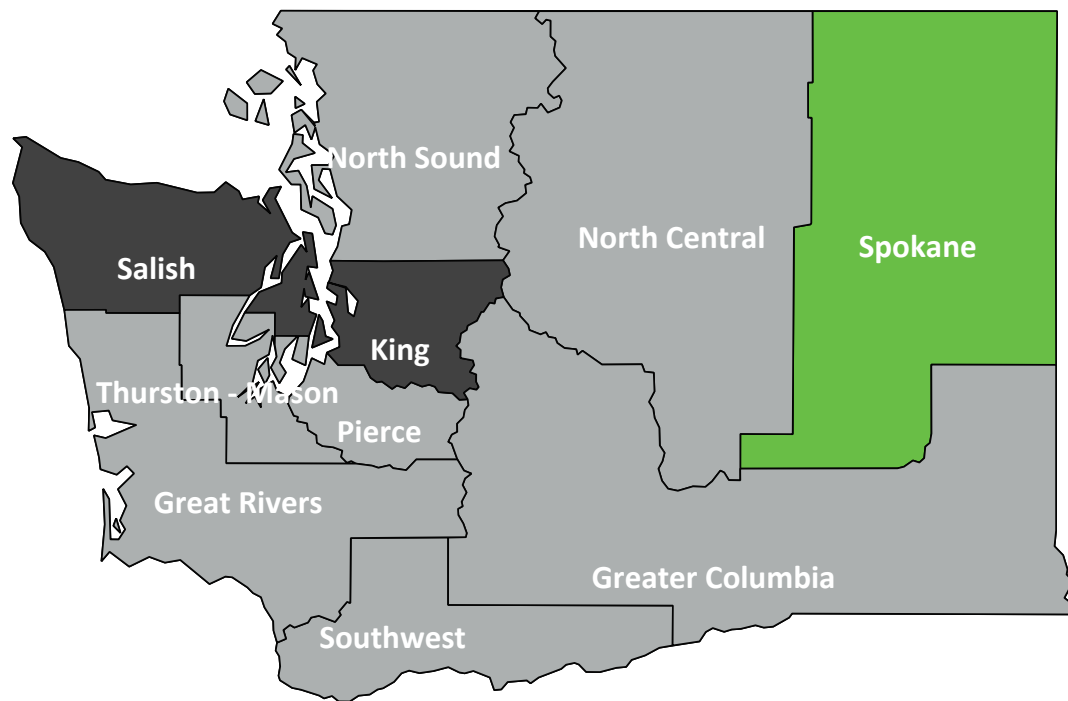

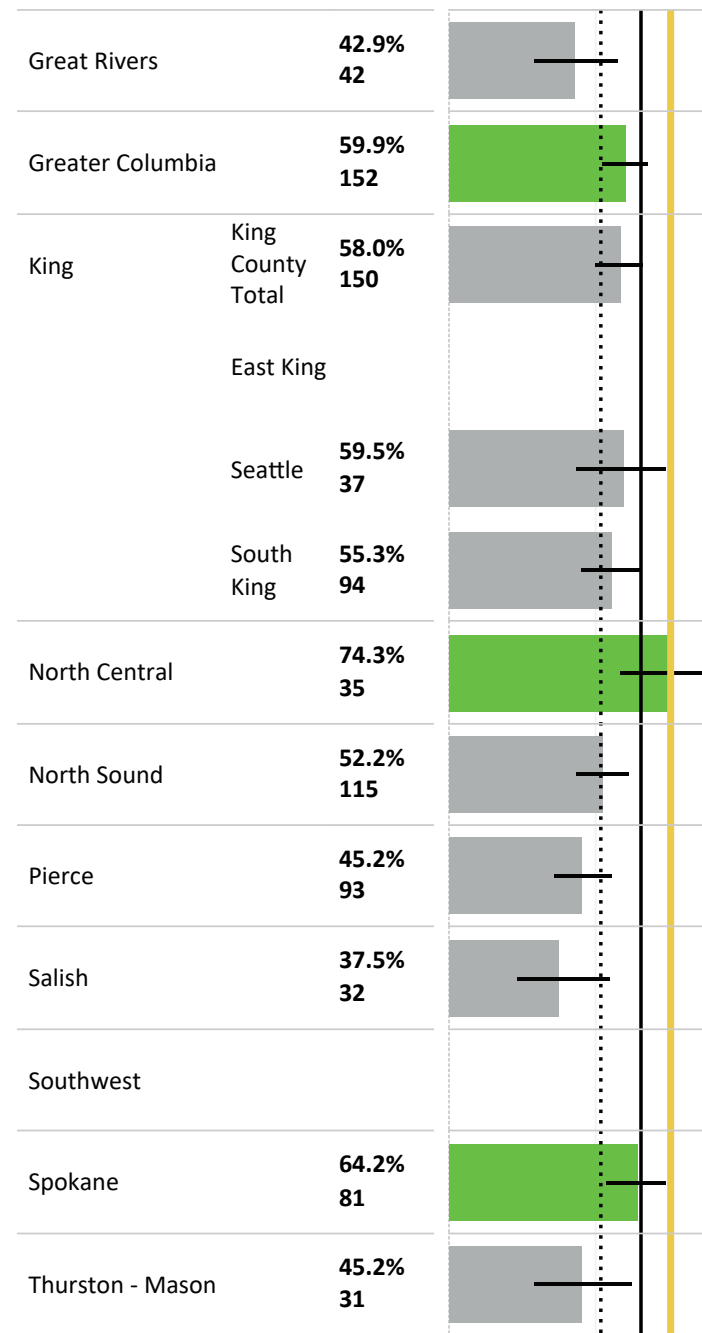

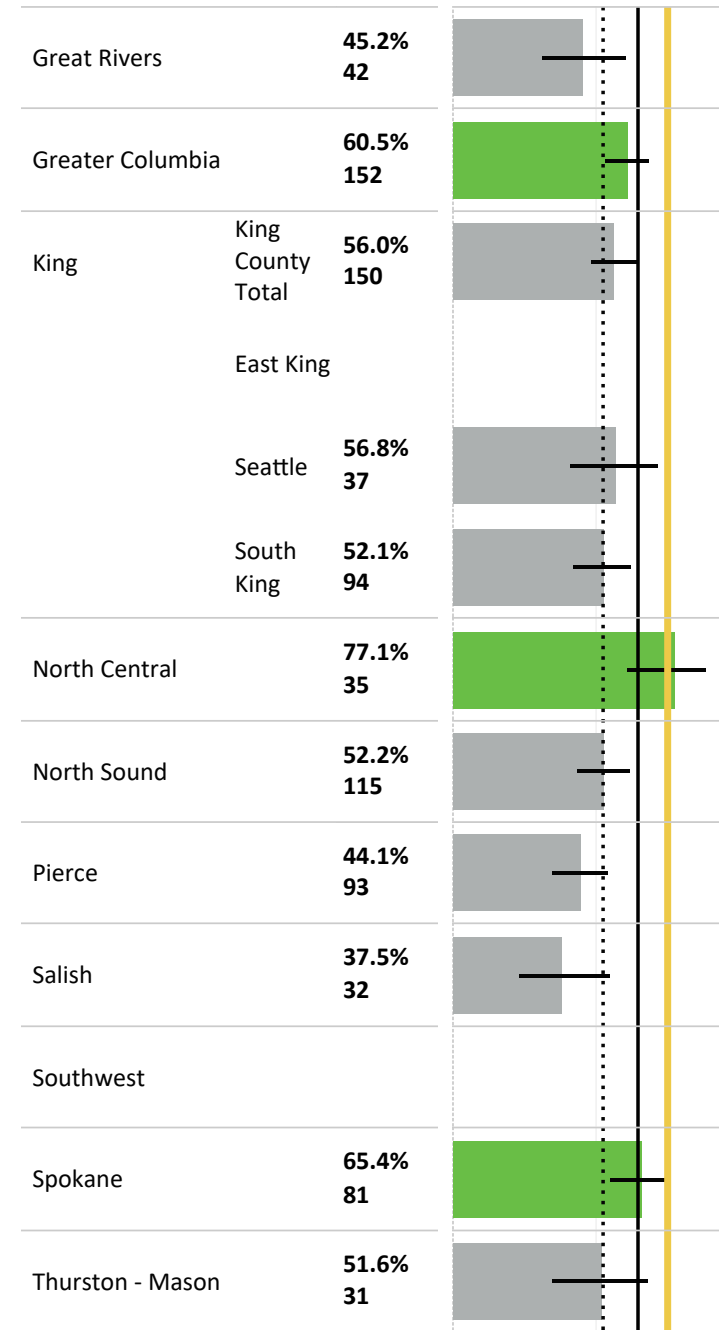

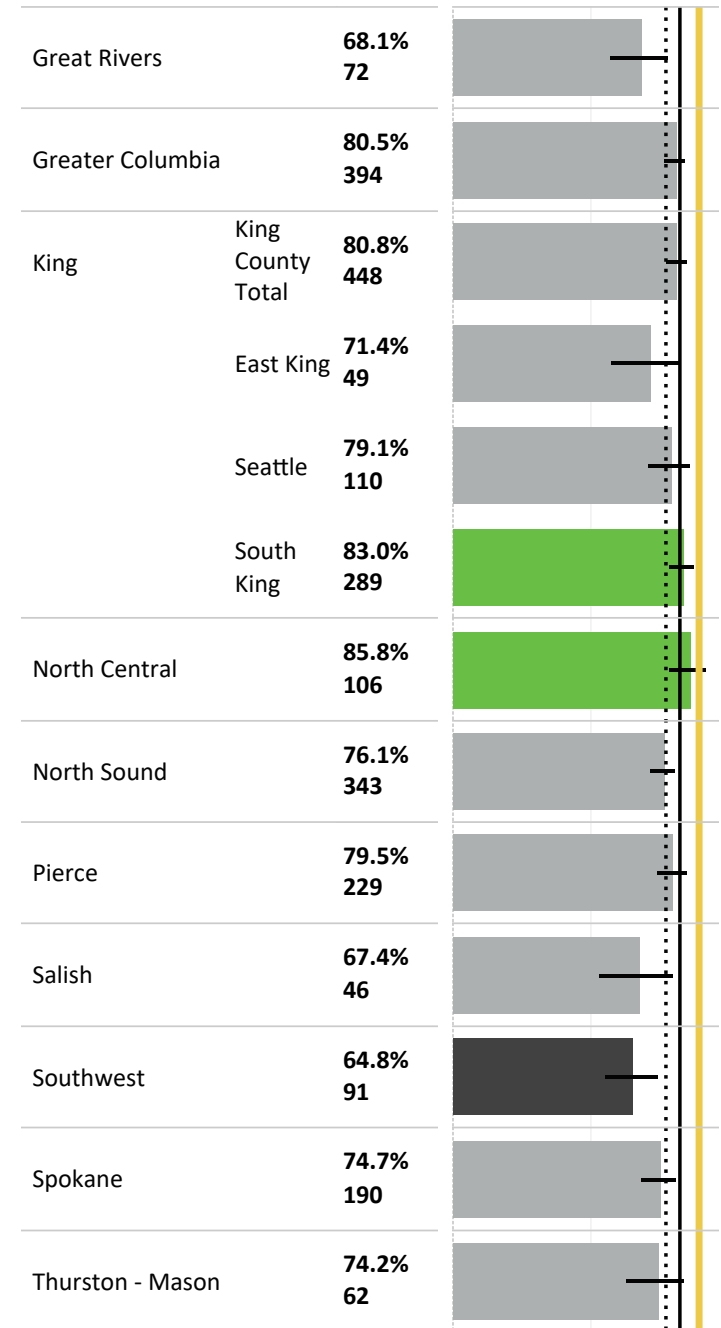

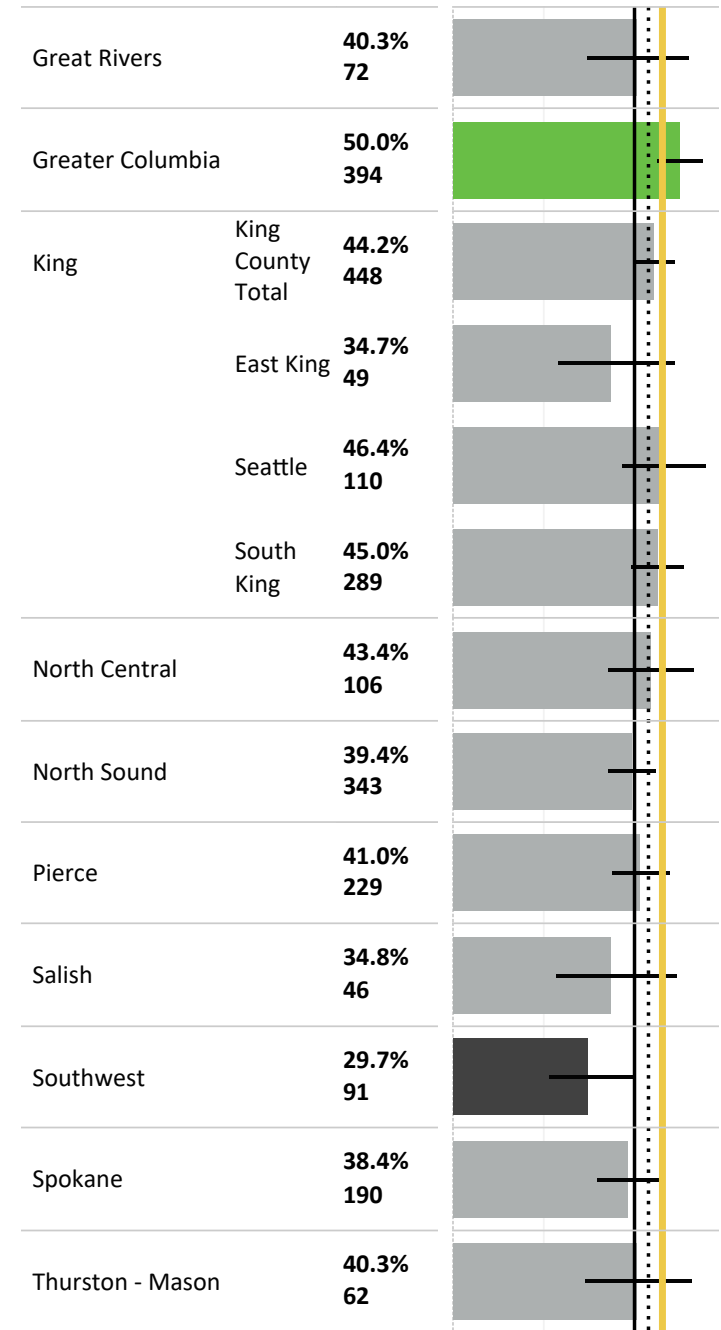

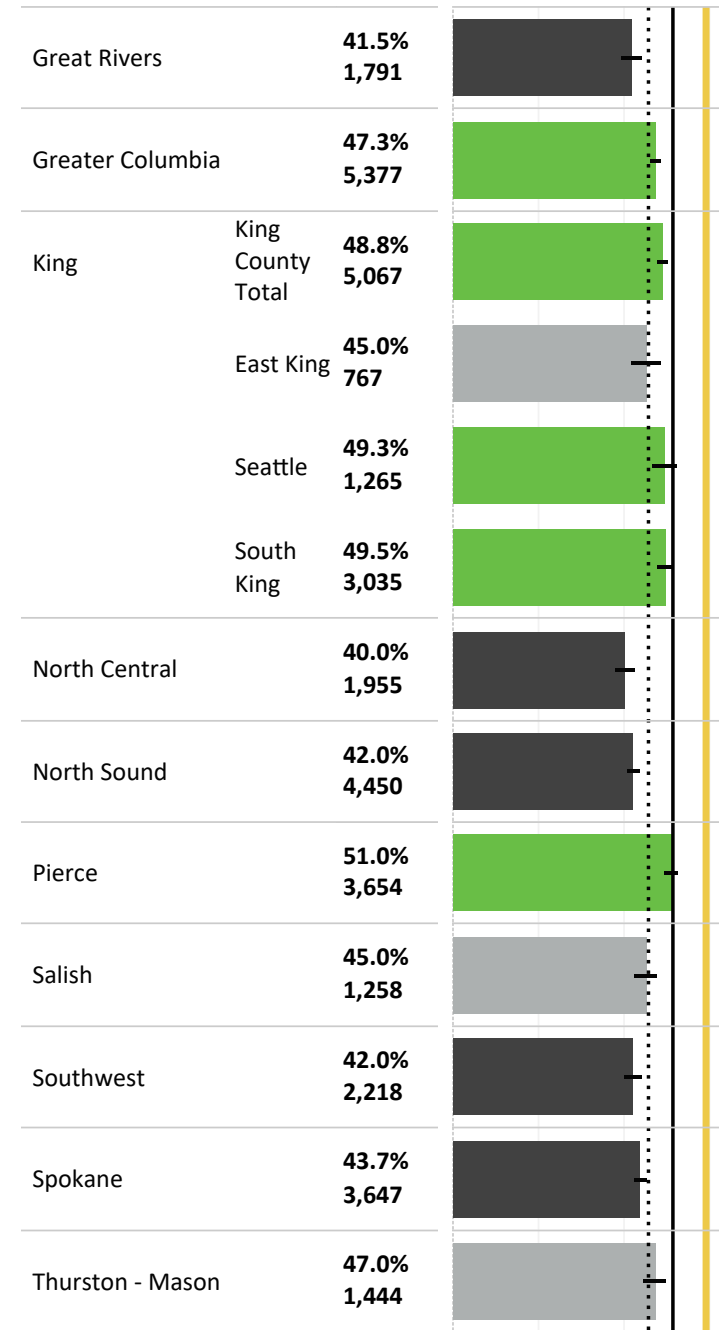

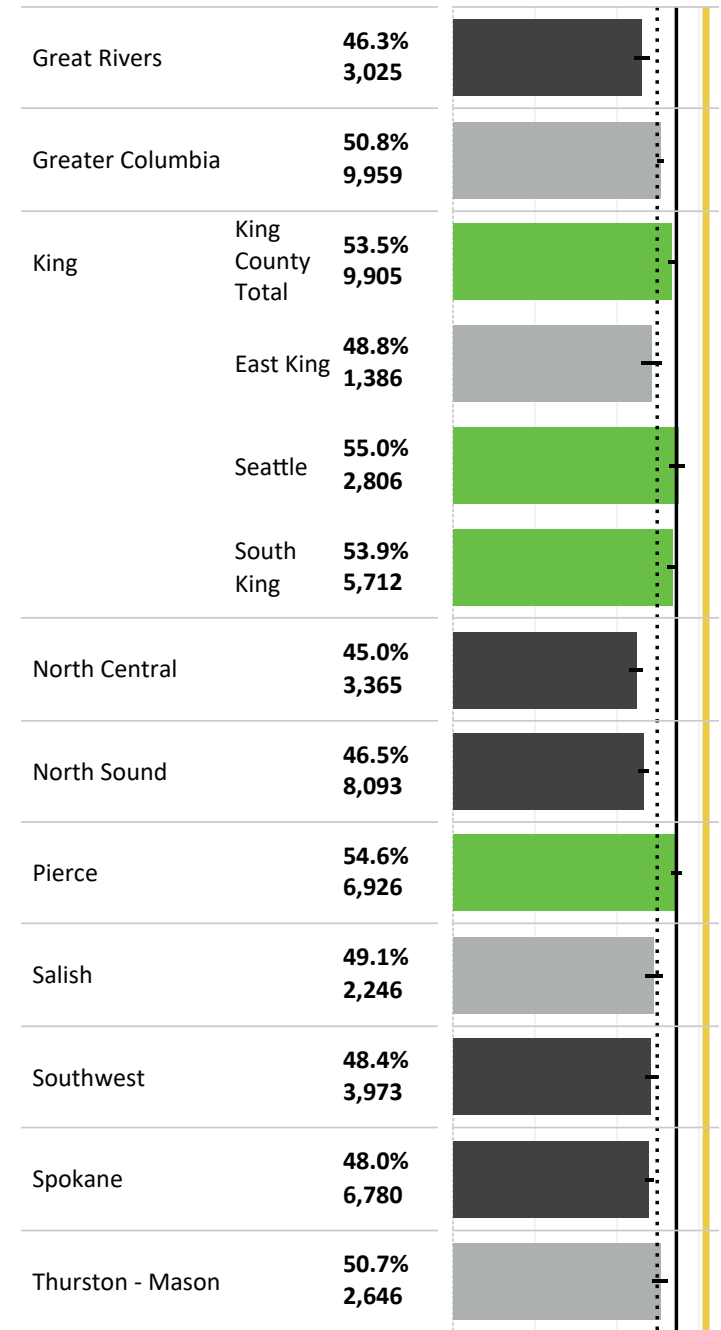

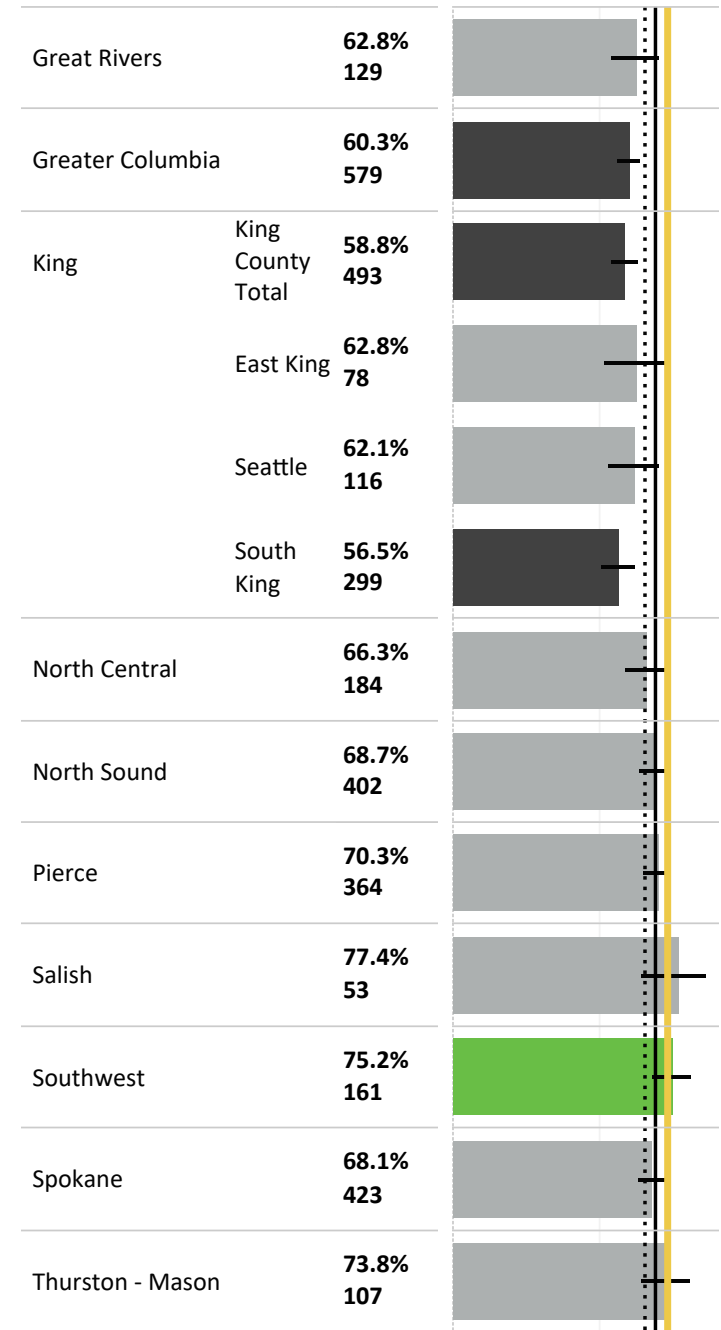

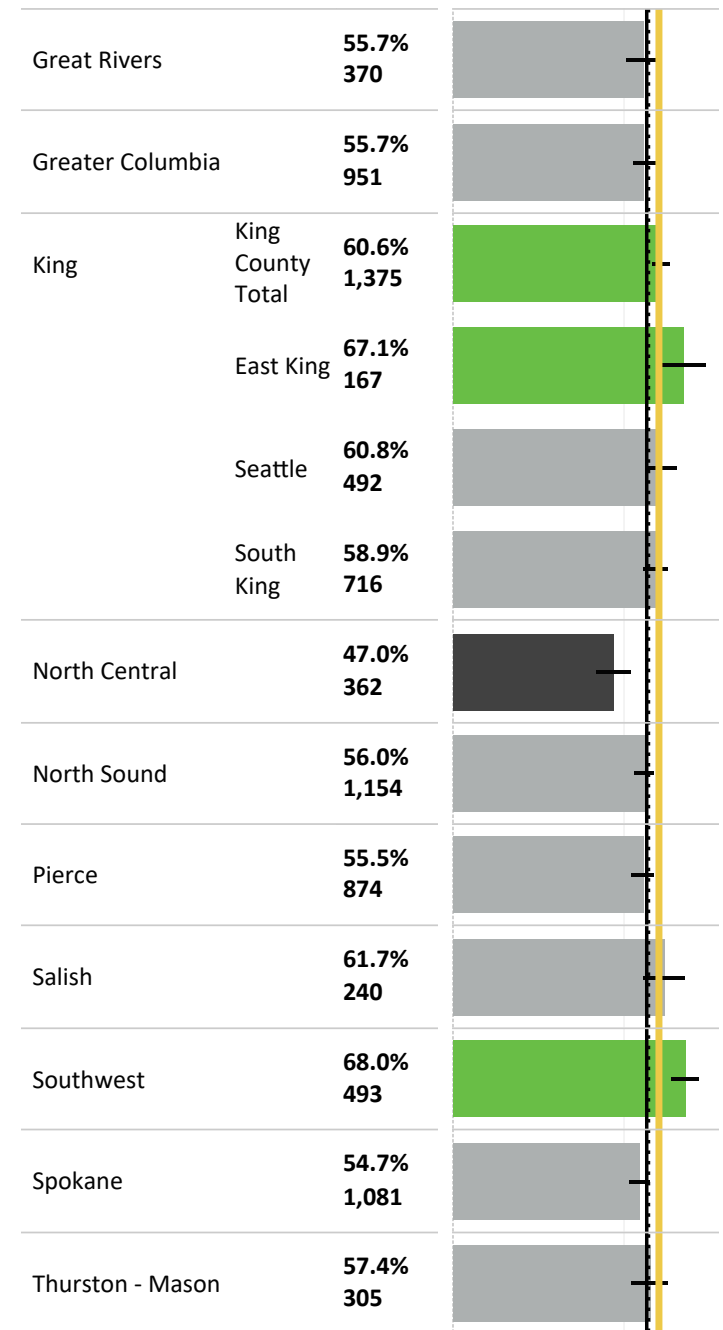

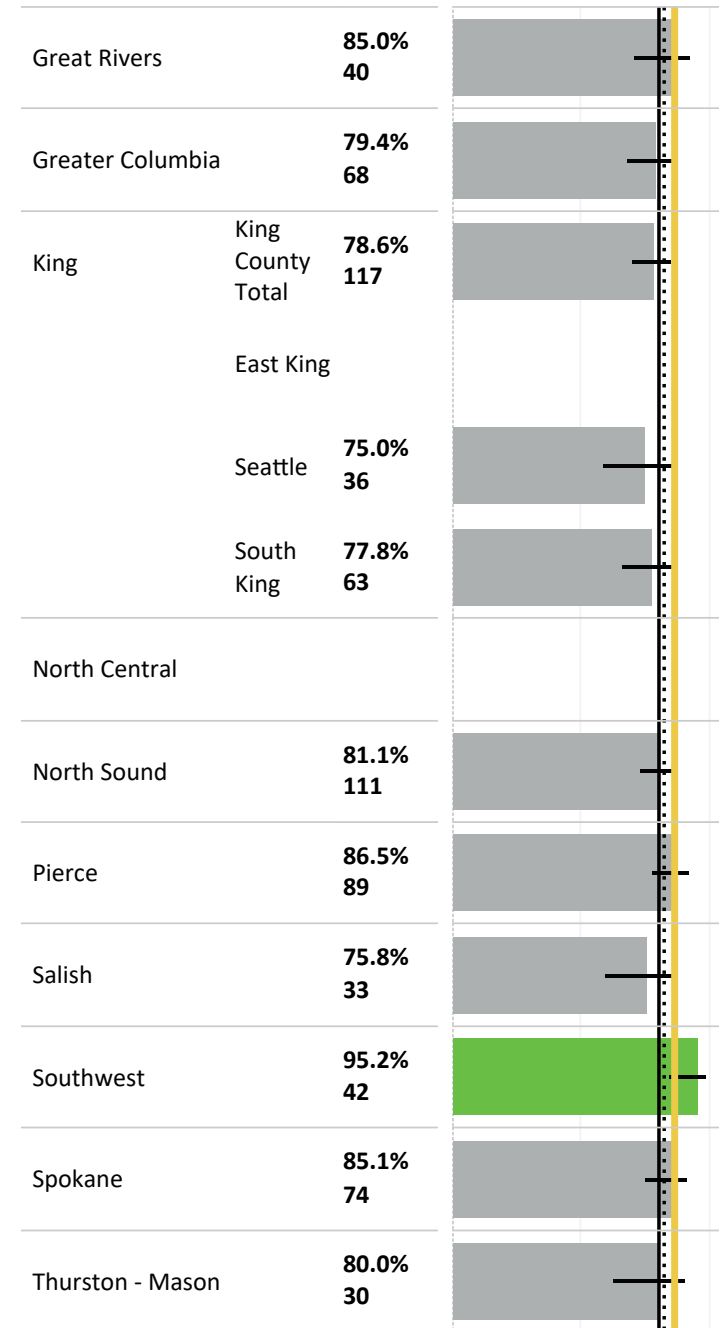

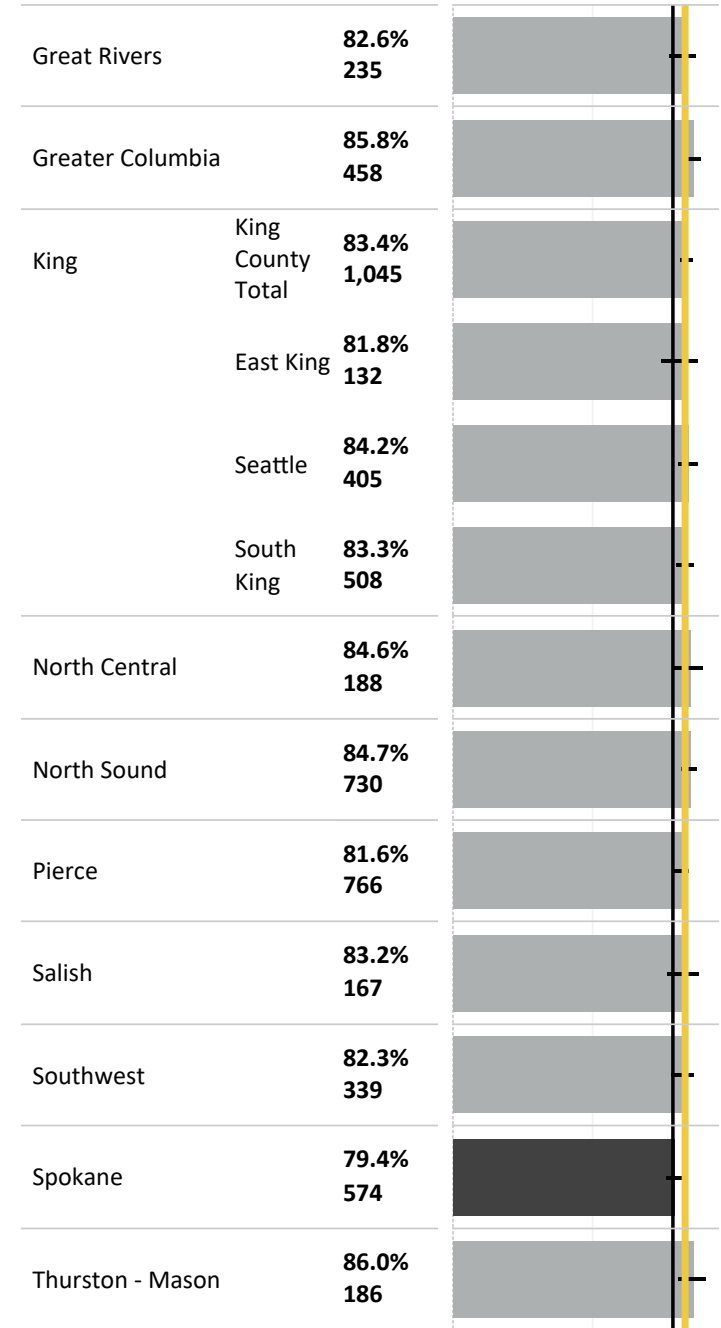

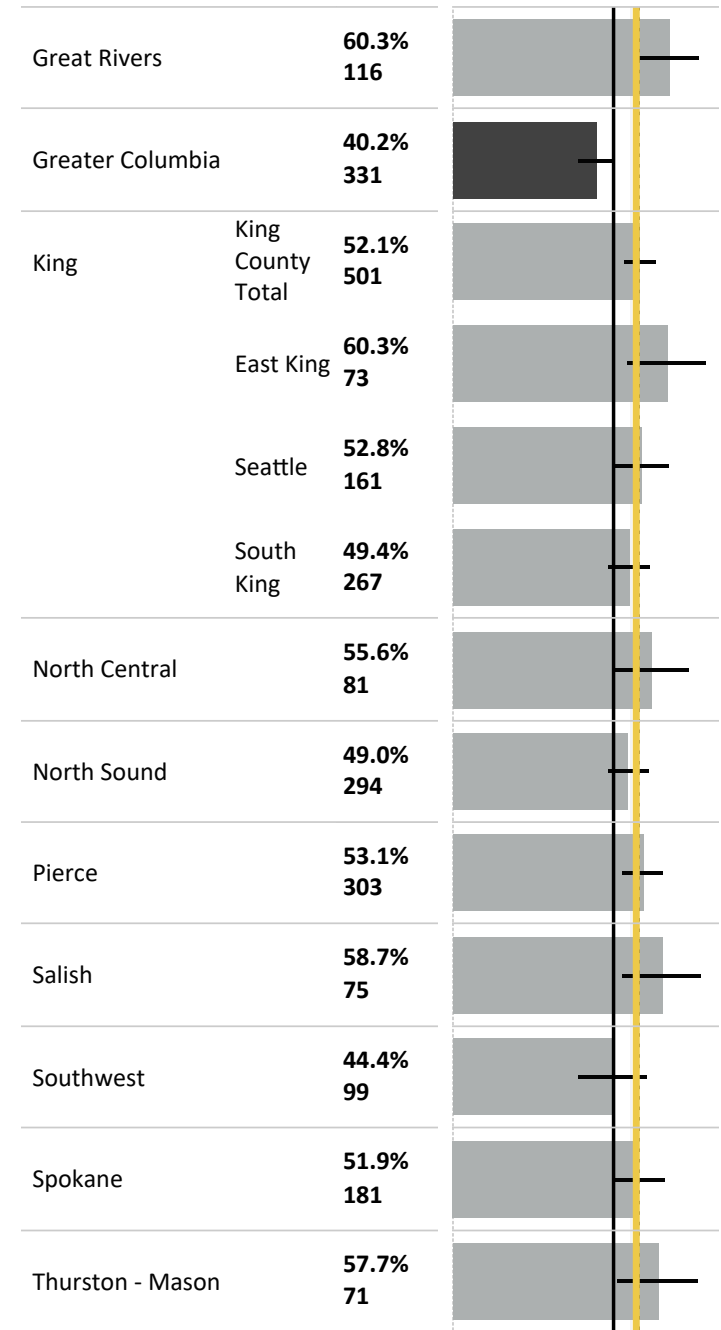

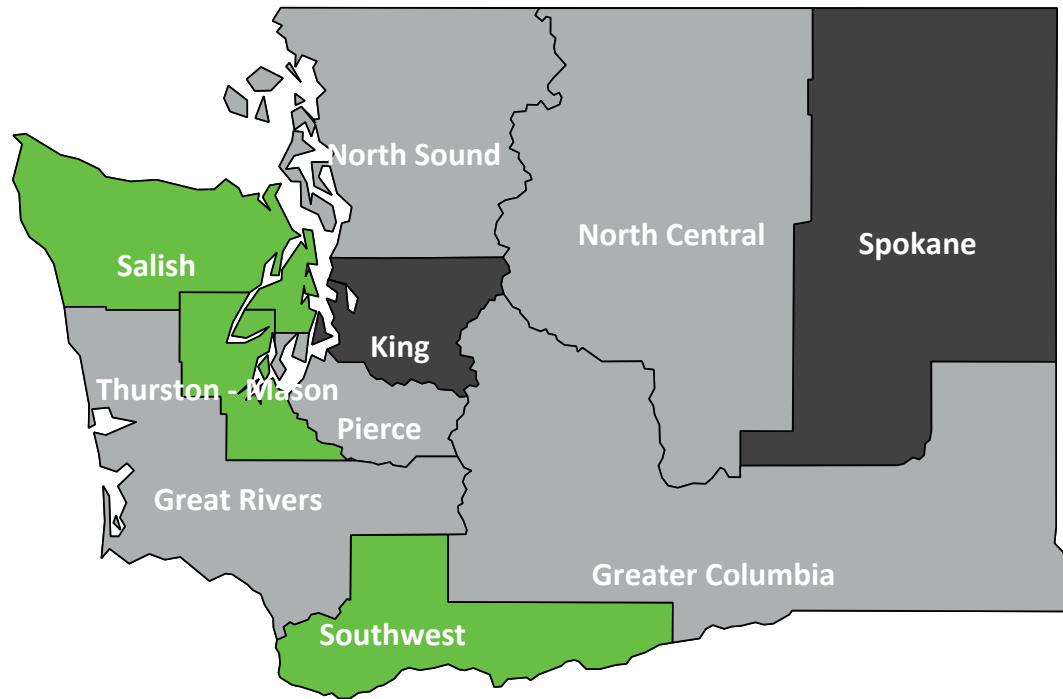

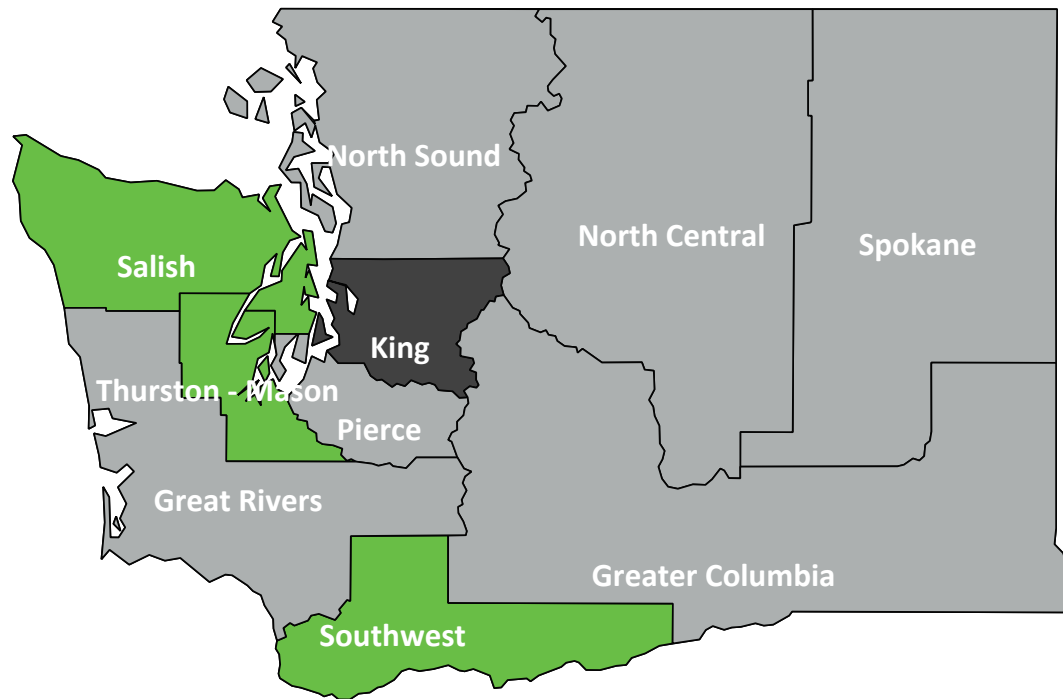

### D-69. Follow-Up Care for Children Prescribed ADHD Medication (ADD), Continuation

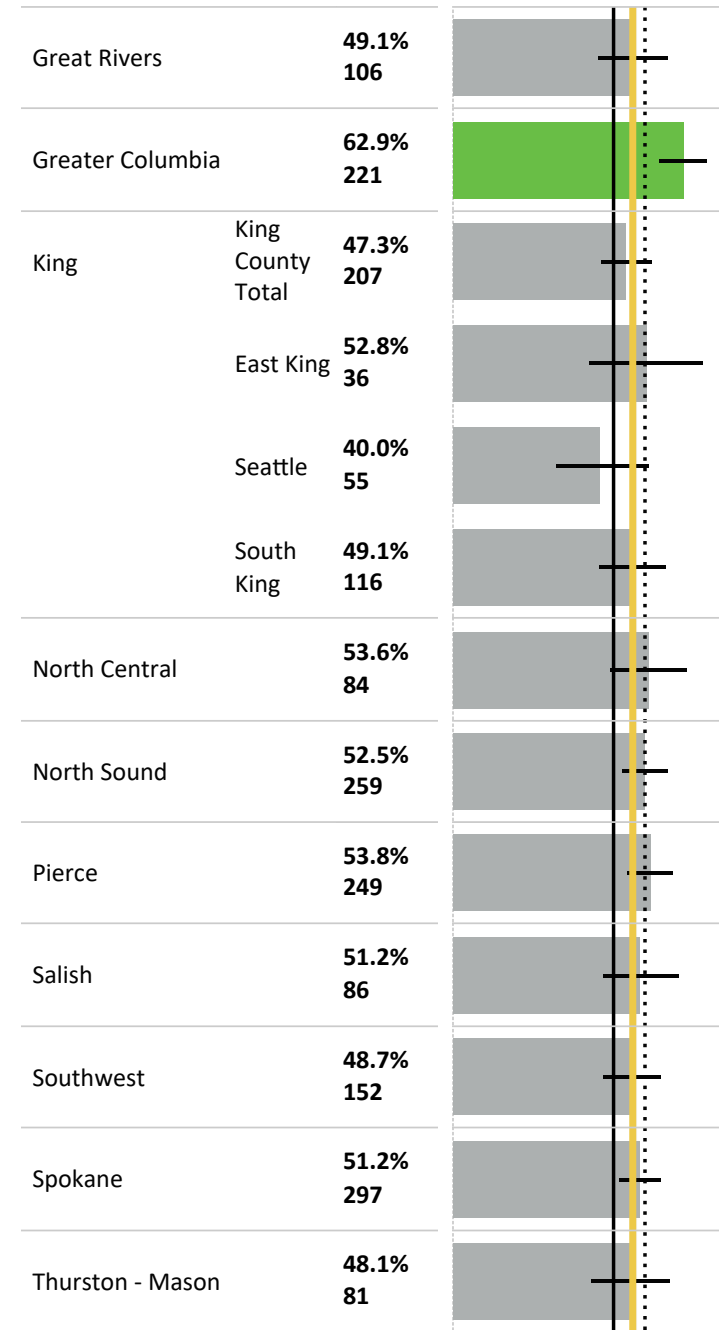

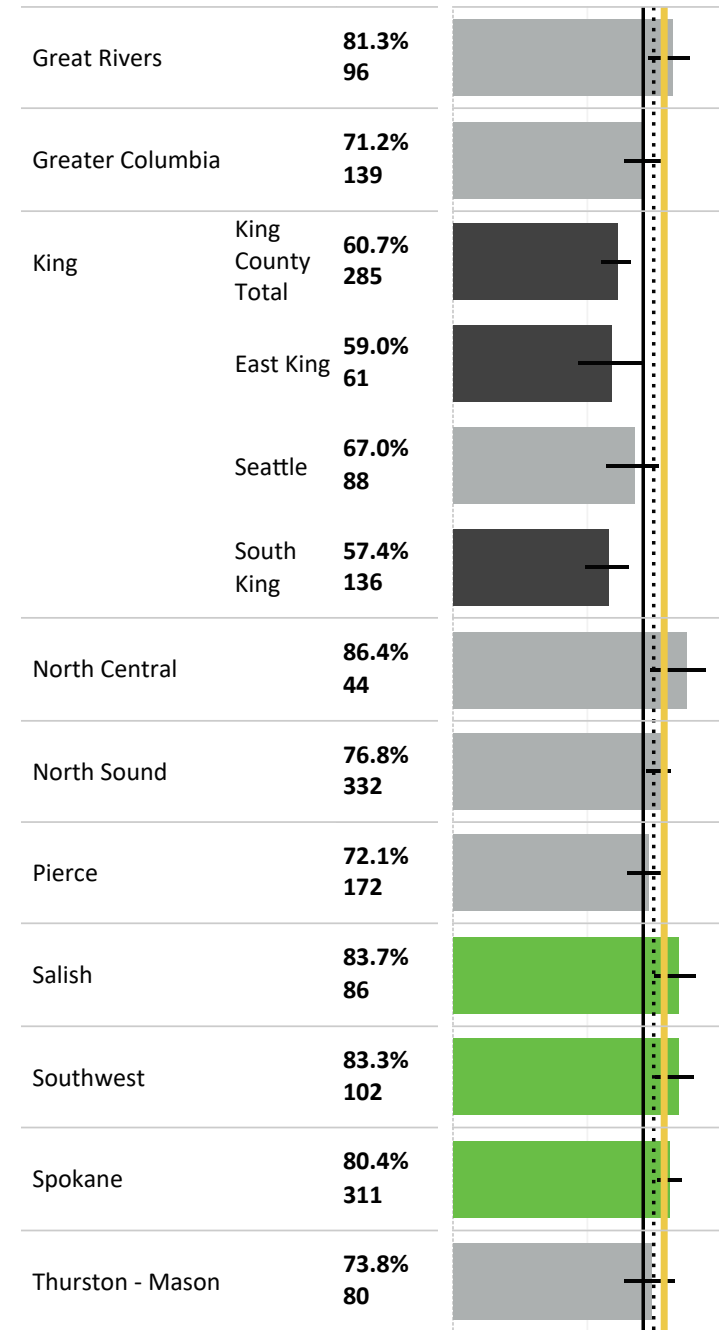
