



#### **CRIS Committee Comments – Overview**

- Overall, the report is a comprehensive reflection of work this year and sets us up for work in 2023. Washington Tribes expressed support for the report and the inclusive process to develop.
- Major areas of comments received to be addressed in the report:
  - 1. Ensure clear message that the report does not yet reflect a complete picture of the system gaps and needs.
  - 2. Need to update and expand upon the data in the report, including regional analysis of services available and access to services by population.
  - 3. Emphasis on topics for further work in 2023
  - 4. Technical corrections to be integrated into report and summarized for Steering Committee with copy of final report.
  - 5. CRIS member written comments also to be included as an appendix to the report.

### CRIS Committee Comments – Areas for Work in 2023

Areas of Work for 2023	CRIS member comments
System goals and metrics	<ul> <li>Inventory of current data and metrics</li> <li>Consideration of variables impacting ability to meet goals/metrics</li> <li>Consequences for not meeting metrics</li> </ul>
Crisis system services	<ul> <li>Deeper analysis of data to understand system gaps by population and geography (service maps by region), including co-response and first responder services, and transportation</li> <li>Clarify roles and expectations for law enforcement</li> <li>Clarify relationship between 911 and 988</li> <li>Focus on building on the existing system and adding best practices</li> <li>Create understanding of who is leading the system, and the role of BH-ASOs at the regional level</li> </ul>
Funding	Funding for 988 call centers to further diversity, equity & inclusion efforts
System Infrastructure	<ul> <li>Further discussion of geo-location and implications for confidentiality</li> <li>Recognition of Vibrant technology platform for future system design</li> <li>Workforce strategies will be critical</li> <li>Need for better understanding of current training for crisis response workers</li> <li>System efficiencies between 988 and RCLs, and coordination btwn 911 and 988</li> </ul>

#### **CRIS Committee Comments – Feedback on Process/Structural Changes**

#### Feedback on Process/Structural Change Recommendations

- Proposal to have a 988 subcommittee in 2023 to discuss geo-location and relationship to confidentiality
  - Bring back recommendations to the legislature in 2024 session
  - Include our 988 call centers, behavioral health leaders/clinicians, and persons with lived experience, and community leaders of communities of color)
- A streamlining of subcommittees, perhaps organized around the categories of crisis services (911 dispatch/ 988 call centers, mobile crisis/ co-response, emergency departments/ crisis triage and stabilization)
- Newsletter about committee deliberations and state agency updates
- More in-person meetings will facilitate the dialogue and the relationships that will be needed
- Incorporate extension of timelines proposed by the legislation
