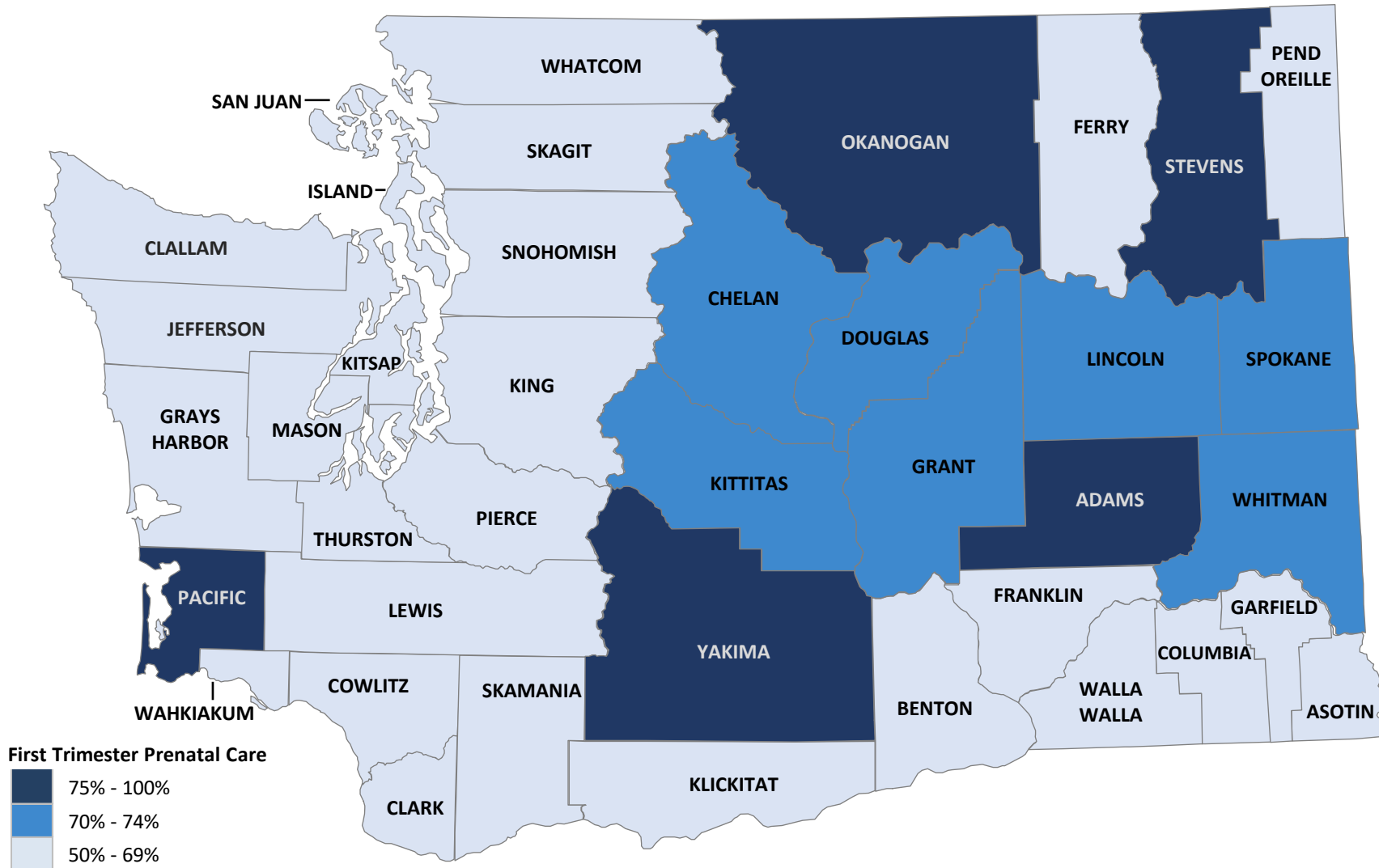


# First Trimester Prenatal Care by County

## For Washington Individuals with Medicaid-paid Perinatal Care Who Gave Birth in 2022



**NOTES:** Medicaid refers to the receipt of Medicaid-paid perinatal services or enrollment in a state-contracted capitated managed care plan for at least three of the last six months before delivery. The Average Number of Prenatal Visits refers to the average (mean) number of prenatal care visits reported on the birth certificate (10.1% of birth certificates for this Medicaid population had missing prenatal care initiation data and were excluded from the calculation). \*\* = suppressed due to small numbers.
