Eliza – clarified that it’s organized by issues that MAY be addressed.  
Purpose: filter out what SUDISA will focus on. She then went through each section and gave an overview for better understanding.

ASAM 4 edition (meant to get someone into service they need/addresses urgent needs)

- Teresa Claycamp – ASAM work is currently focused on the 4th edition which is for adults. Currently in a “wait & see” period for youth version.
- Khan Qudisia asked updates/understanding on ASAM 4<sup>th</sup> edition? Kelley will send Teresa’s presentation/PPT to Dr. Khan

State Plan Amendments/Aligning w/ DOH/Legislation

- Teresa Claycamp – opened peer service as related to crisis/ added language to allow peer intervention & flexibility.
- Potential for more work to be done in this section/State Plan needs clinician for intervention.
- Teresa noted room for recommendations from workgroup re SPA changes/has policies & procedures for this.
- Dominique – everyone will have the ability to administer an assessment be trained in ASAM? Agencies specific/ensure workforce has proper training. 4<sup>th</sup> edition will launch training.

Desired Results/Goals without Recommended Solutions/Ongoing Information Communications

- Purpose: Identify potential issues where agencies do not have proper training. Ex: removals of the X waiver to prescribe buprenorphine
- Charney Ducret re MAT: Look into federal regulations for methadone/CFR 42 rules.
- TW & Meta Hogan – doctors may not feel qualified to provide prescriptions for MOUD/put on MURAL.
- Dr. Khan asked if there was an example re buprenorphine and hesitancy to prescribe. Eliza provided context.
- Note of cost/funding for outpatient billable service for suboxone.
- Medical doctors do their own assessment. Different than SUD dimensional assessment.
- Wait times/larger barrier of transferring from hospital to inpatient care.
- Location of the patient

Ongoing Policy/Rule/Requirement Issue

- Lack of staffing

			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Inpatient treatment does not offer medically managed care beyond withdrawal management.</li> <li>▪ “Medically monitored” means doctor is on call to prescribe and manage medications but does not include acute medical conditions beyond addictions.</li> </ul> <p>Teresa – (in motion right now) Rural health centers who are non-BHA setting able to hire SUDPs &amp; those SUDPs can do assessments, services, intervention, and treatment.</p> <p>Brandy – re-communicating that providers can accept each other’s assessments w/o consequences.</p> <p>Two workgroups looking at ASAM criteria re standardizations (to put on group’s radar)</p>
