Fact: During 2022, residents in the WA Network of Oxford Houses will pay approximately \$7,818,080 for their own household expenses for the 347 houses (3026 beds) now in the state.



COST-BENEFIT APPROACH

A traditional halfway house system to accommodate the same amount of beds would have cost taxpayers between \$61.2 and 104.1 million dollars a year.



Instead, the state is paying OHI a fraction of that to develop and maintain the statewide network of 347 self-supporting Oxford Houses.





EVIDENCE-BASED PRACTICE

In 2011 the federal government [SAMHSA] listed Oxford House as a best practices on the National Registry of Evidence-based Practices and Procedures [NREPP]

Oxford House gives people in recovery from all backgrounds a great chance at long-term recovery.


