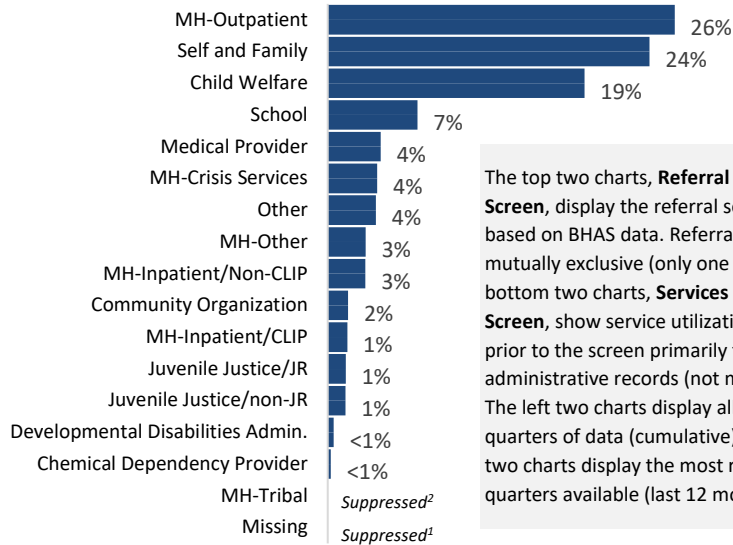

### Referral Source for WISe Screen

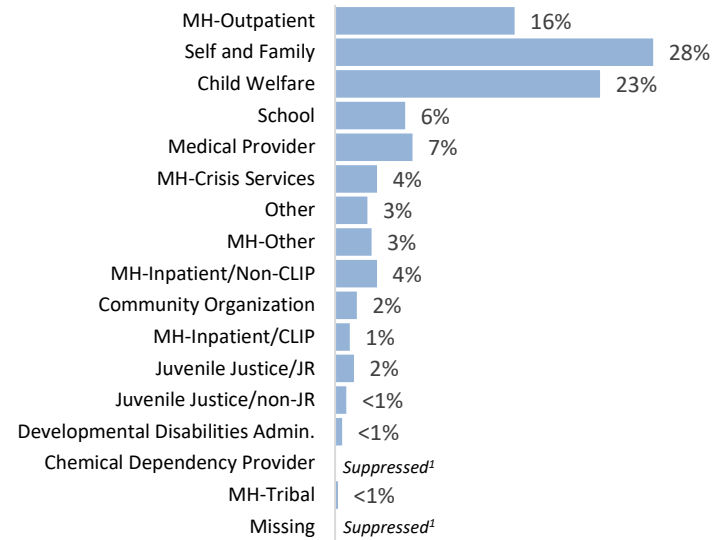

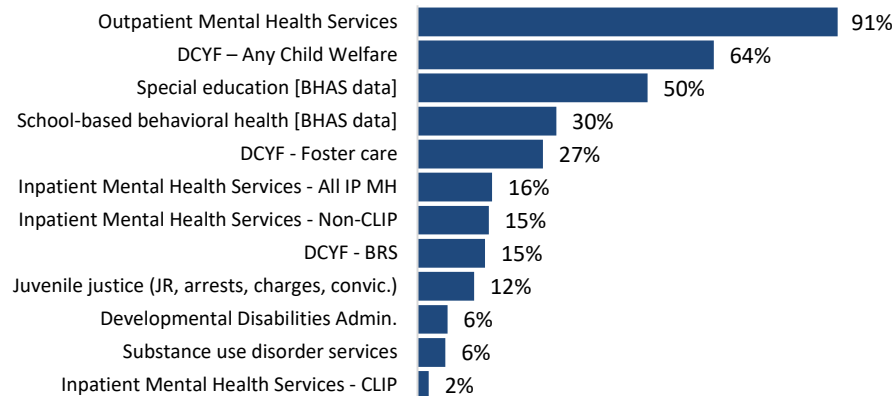
#### LAST 12 MONTHS October 2020 - September 2021



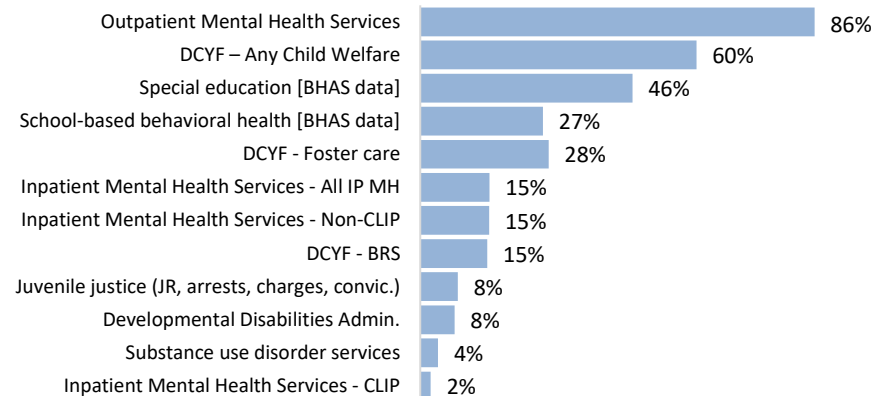

#### LAST 12 MONTHS July 2020 - June 2021

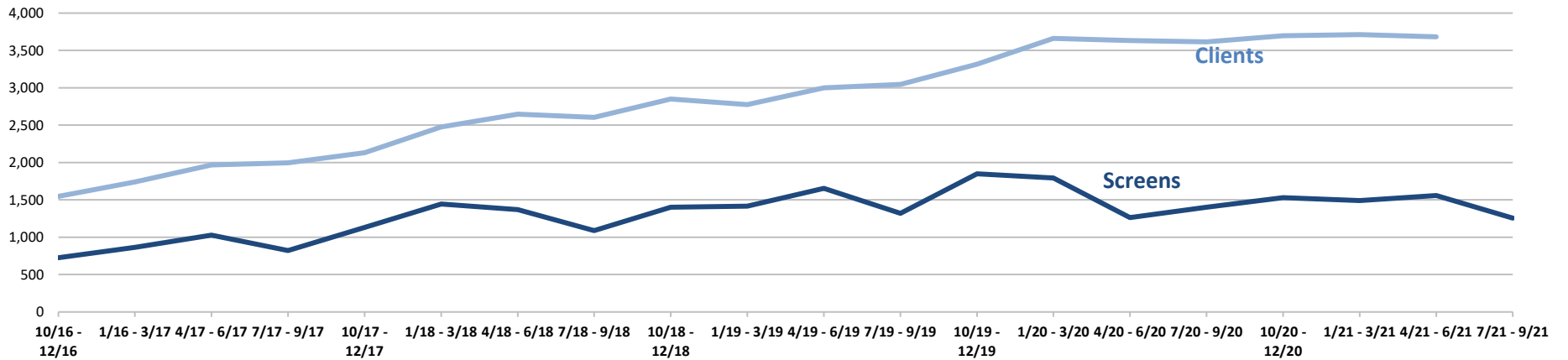
