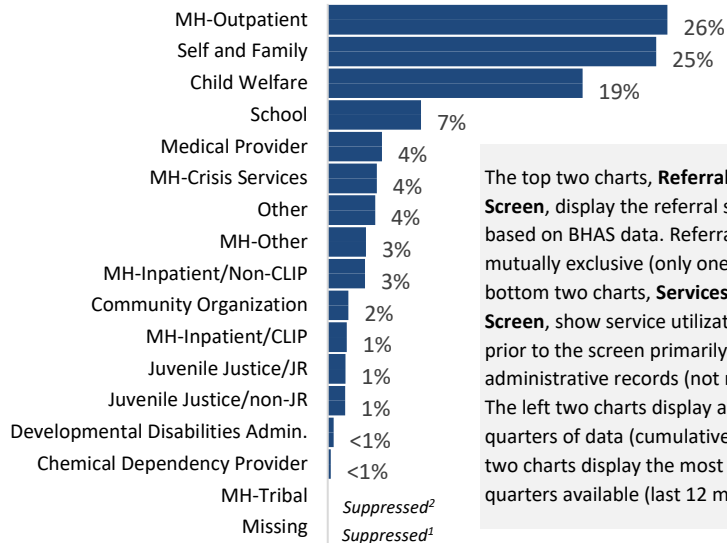

### Referral Source for WISe Screen

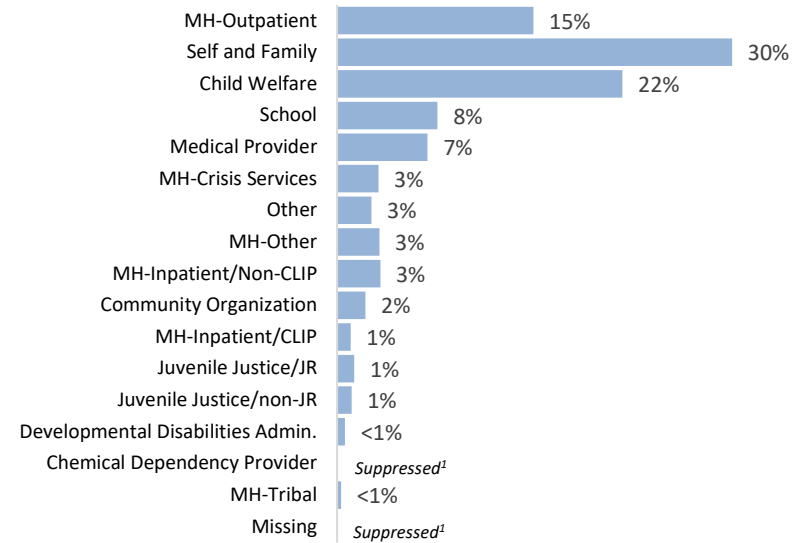

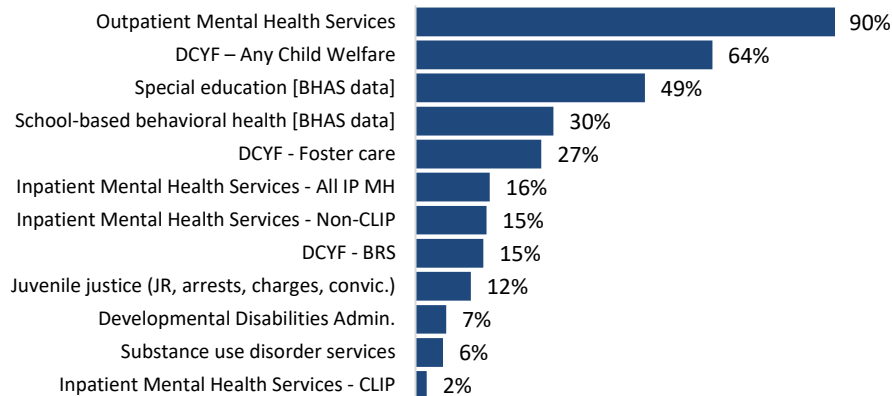
**LAST 12 MONTHS** January 2021 - December 2021



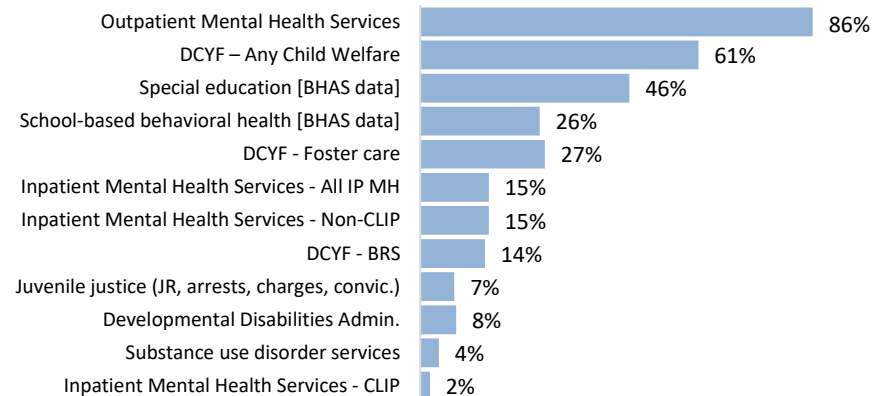
### Services 12 Months Before Screen

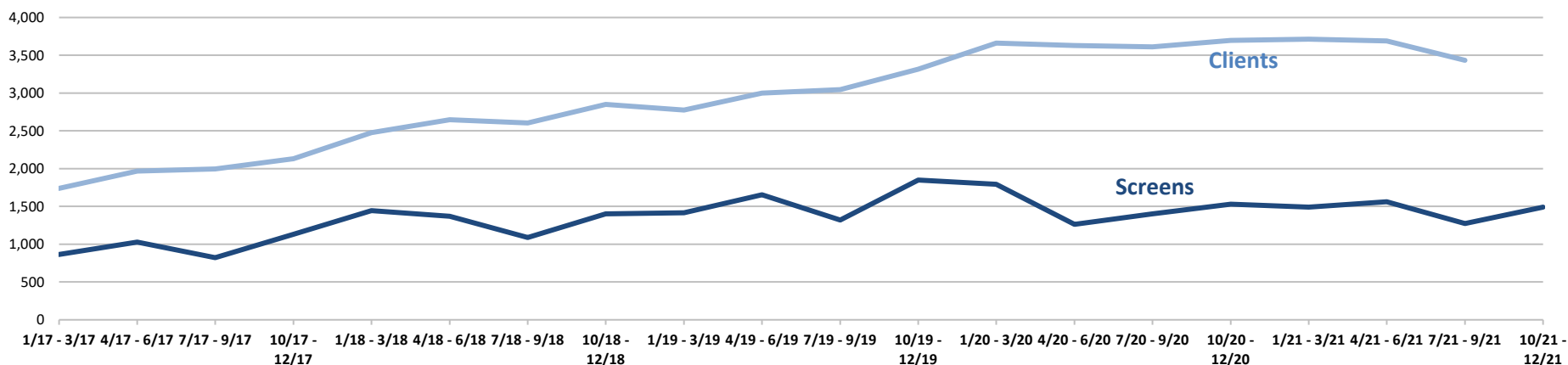
