



Affordable Coverage for Workers with Disabilities

Apple Health for Workers with Disabilities (HWD) is an affordable, low-cost health care coverage option for people with disabilities who want to work and save more of their earnings.

Get primary care, behavioral health services, dental services, vision care, and prescriptions.

There is no income or resource limit to qualify for HWD, so you can earn and save more.

YOU MIGHT QUALIFY FOR COVERAGE IF YOU...

- Meet federal disability requirements.
- Work part-time, full-time, or are self-employed.
- Are a U.S. citizen or have a qualifying immigration status.
- Live in Washington.
- Are at least 16 years old.
