Washington Healthplanfinder will update to 11.3 on February 15, 2024, at 7:00 a.m.

Customer-facing updates

- Beginning March 9th, 2024, clients who have children ages 0-6 enrolled in Washington Apple Health for Kids will now see the child's continuous eligibility for the program reflected in correspondences (EE008 Apple Health Renewal and EE015 Eligibility Results) and their eligibility results text. Coverage is continuous regardless of changes in the household's income.

You qualify for Apple Health based on the information you provided. We have not reviewed your eligibility for a Qualified Health Plan, tax credits or Cascade Care Savings because of this. Osvaldo Jennings is eligible for free Apple Health for Kids. Children under six years old who are on free Apple Health for Kids receive continuous eligibility through the month they turn six even if income increases. - The *Add Household Member* screen in HPF has been changed to *Edit Household Member* instead of listing the name of the member.
- Customers will receive an error message if an invalid A-number (found on Permanent Resident Cards) is entered.

Other changes

- Washington Apple Health plan cards will now display the correct information without encountering an error. This will allow customers to have the option to select a new plan when they report a change of address and are required to change their current plan.
