**Title or Subject: Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) State Plan Amendments 24-3000, 24-4000, and 24-5000**

**Effective Date:** November 1, 2024

**Description:** The Health Care Authority (HCA) intends to submit the following Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) State Plan Amendments (SPAs):

- 24-3000 will update various items including links, program names, WAC references, available supported languages.
- 24-4000 will remove lock out periods for non-payment of premiums for CHIP-eligible children.
- 24-5000 will increase the percentage of the Federal Poverty Level (FPL) from 193% to 210% for eligibility for the agency's pregnancy-related programs.

These SPAs are expected to have no effect on the annual aggregate expenditures, reimbursement, or payment for CHIP programs as they address non-financially-related updates and eligibility only.

All these SPAs are in the development process; therefore, copies are not yet available for review. HCA would appreciate any input or concerns regarding this SPA.
