Subject: Medicaid Transformation Project (MTP) case management rate methodology under the Health-Related Social Needs (HRSN) program

Effective Date: July 1, 2024

The Health Care Authority (HCA) submitted a rate methodology for case management under MTP 2.0.¹ These services are case management, outreach, and educational services that aim to provide connections to other state and federal benefit programs, benefit program application assistance, and benefit program application fees.

Case management rates are expected to **increase** the annual aggregate expenditures by \$65 million under MTP 2.0. Nine Community Hubs and one Native Hub will receive funding from HCA to perform these services.

¹ MTP is Washington State's Section 1115 Medicaid demonstration waiver. MTP 2.0 is the renewal for MTP, which allows the state to continue MTP for an additional five years. MTP 2.0 began on July 1, 2023.
