## **NOTICE**

Medicaid Transformation Project (MTP) Personal Care and Homemaker Services Rate Methodology under Health-Related Social Needs (HRSN) program

Effective Date: February 1, 2025

The Health Care Authority (HCA) intends to submit a rate methodology for Personal care and homemaker services under Medicaid Transformation Project (MTP 2.0 – section 1115 waiver). These services provide short-term care, including meals and ongoing monitoring of the individual's ongoing medical or behavioral condition, and may include limited or short-term assistance with Instrumental Activities of Daily Living (IADLs) and/or Activities of Daily Living (ADLs), for individuals who do not qualify for Home and Community Based Services to continue their community stabilization.

Personal care and homemaker services is expected to *increase* the annual aggregate expenditures for providers by approximately \$52 million under MTP 2.0. Providers will be able to access Medicaid waiver funds to provide Personal care and homemaker services.
