

How to apply for coverage

Online

Applying online will quickly show you whether you're eligible for free or low-cost coverage through Apple Health. **You can apply anytime, year-round. Get started at wahealthplanfinder.org.**

You'll need this information before you begin:

- Your household monthly income.
- Your immigration information, if that applies to you.
- Dates of birth for each member of your household.
- Social Security numbers for each household member applying for coverage, if that applies to you.

Are you eligible?

Apple Health for Adults

You may be eligible if:

- You are between 19 and 65 years old.
- You are a Washington resident.
- You are a U.S. citizen or meet Medicaid immigration requirements.
- Your annual household income is at or below the amounts shown in the Income eligibility table to the right.

Apple Health for Pregnant Individuals

This program provides coverage to pregnant individuals with countable income at or below 215 percent of the federal poverty level without regard to citizenship or immigration status. After-Pregnancy Coverage (APC) provides coverage after your pregnancy ends.

Apple Health for Kids

Coverage is free to children in households with income at or below 215 percent of the federal poverty level and available for a low monthly premium to children in households with income at or below 317 percent of the federal poverty level. See the Income eligibility table to the right.



Important Reminders

See if you're eligible for Washington Apple Health (Medicaid) at hca.wa.gov/apple-health-eligibility. You can sign up anytime, year-round, at wahealthplanfinder.org.

If you're not eligible for Apple Health, you may qualify for help with your health insurance or for other health services.
