Your routine vision coverage will end December 31, 2024

Dear Subscriber:

Starting January 1, 2025, the PEBB Program will offer standalone vision coverage, which means routine vision coverage will be separate from medical coverage. Because your employer offers only medical coverage, routine vision coverage through your PEBB benefits will end December 31, 2024.

Treatment for medical conditions such as infection, eye diseases like glaucoma, and eye injuries will continue to be covered under your PEBB medical plan. Through December 31, 2024, you can continue to use your existing vision coverage through your medical plan.

Are there other routine vision coverage options available?

There may be other options available to you and your dependents for routine vision coverage after your current coverage ends, such as a spouse's plan or individual vision plans you can purchase. Check with your payroll or benefits office for guidance on vision coverage options.
