
Question 1

Are you a union represented PEBB member?



Question 2

Is your union part of the health care coalition described in RCW 41.80.020(3)?



Question 3

Is your rate of pay on November 1, 2024, \$60,000 or less for a full-time equivalent position?

This means that you may still qualify even if you work part-time, so long as full-time pay would meet this condition.

For example, if an employee earns \$30,000 and works 20 hours per week, their full-time salary would be \$60,000 and they would qualify.
