Financial Help for CDR Contributors

The WA Link4Health Clinical Data Repository (CDR) is a patient-centric database designed to help care teams of Apple Health Managed Care enrollees gain a more comprehensive understanding of their patients' medical history. If you are required to participate in the first stage of the CDR rollout (e.g., you are contracted with a Managed Care Organization, you treat Apple Health Managed Care Enrollees, and you have a 2014 certified EHR), you are eligible to participate in the incentive program described below. The Washington Health Care Authority and OneHealthPort are working together to explore ways of removing barriers to participation in the Clinical Data Repository (CDR). As part of this effort, OneHealthPort is offering a one-time HIE subscription discount for providers who meet specific criteria.

Providers who are required to participate in the first stage of the CDR rollout and who meet the following criteria will receive a **one-time discount of \$600 off of their annual HIE subscription**. \$150,000 in incentive dollars are available. The incentive will be issued on a first come, first served basis to providers up to the \$150,000 limit.

Incentive Criteria:

- Send C-CDAs to the CDR, for all Medicaid encounters, using the production system by 06/01/17.
- Send C-CDAs to the CDR, with the following components able to parse; Problems, Procedures, Medications, Allergies, Labs, Vital Signs and Immunizations.
- Providers must continue to submit C-CDAs for all Medicaid encounters. For purposes of paying the incentive, OHP will consider the criteria satisfied after 30 days of ongoing submissions.
- Until 10/01/17, the provider is not obligated to correct and resubmit to the CDR patient records that fail due to matching errors.

Clinical Data Repository (CDR) Update

The CDR is now accepting clinical summary data submissions!!

The Link4Health Clinical Data Repository (CDR) is now open to health care organizations and their vendors who have successfully completed their readiness activities. Providers can now submit their clinical summaries in a standard electronic format called a Continuity of Care Document (CCD) after each outpatient encounter or inpatient admission.

This accomplishment is the result of significant work by OneHealthPort (OHP), the state health information exchange, in collaboration with providers and their

electronic health record (EHR) vendors. HCA and our partner MCO's want to thank those organizations who have completed work with their vendor as "first movers" and stand ready for Production.

To recap some of the key milestones to date:

- Providers are submitting CCD files and several are nearing completion with their testing
- The health record has been established for 1.7M Apple Health consumers
- Historical claims since Jan 2016 have been loaded into the CDR
- Various security reviews have been completed, including one by the state Office of the CIO
- The existing OHP Single Sign On service has been leveraged for CDR access
- OHP has completed work on technical changes to allow various options for providers to submit their CCD files and to match the clinical data to the correct patient in the CDR.

Providers required to submit CCD files for their Apple Health Managed Care enrollees should contact OneHealthPort as soon as possible to begin technical readiness work. They should also contact their EHR vendor to start testing. CDR Fees for Connectivity Survey Update

We recently distributed a survey asking providers to let us know if their EHR vendor was quoting them fees for the use of the CDR. The survey is still ongoing but we wanted to share some of the results with you.

Monthly fees range from \$30 - \$1200

Annual fees range from \$540 - \$4929

Implementation fees range from \$500 - \$31,401
