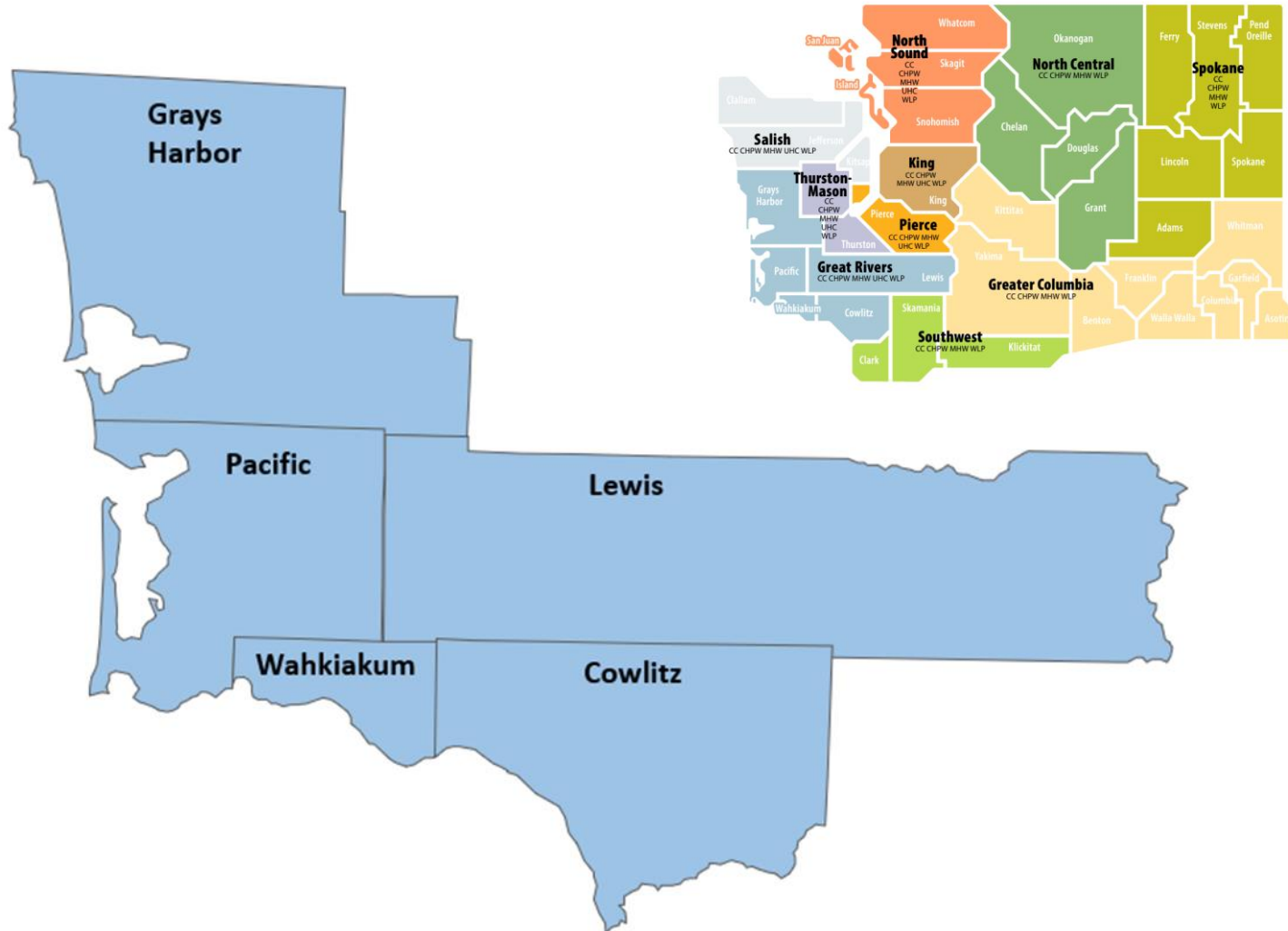


Our Mission: To Provide access to high-quality, cost-efficient behavioral health services to empower individuals and families in managing their health, safety, and well-being.

Our Vision: Fostering highly-skilled and collaborative system of providers to support individuals and family needs, improve access to healthcare, and build strengths to their capacity.

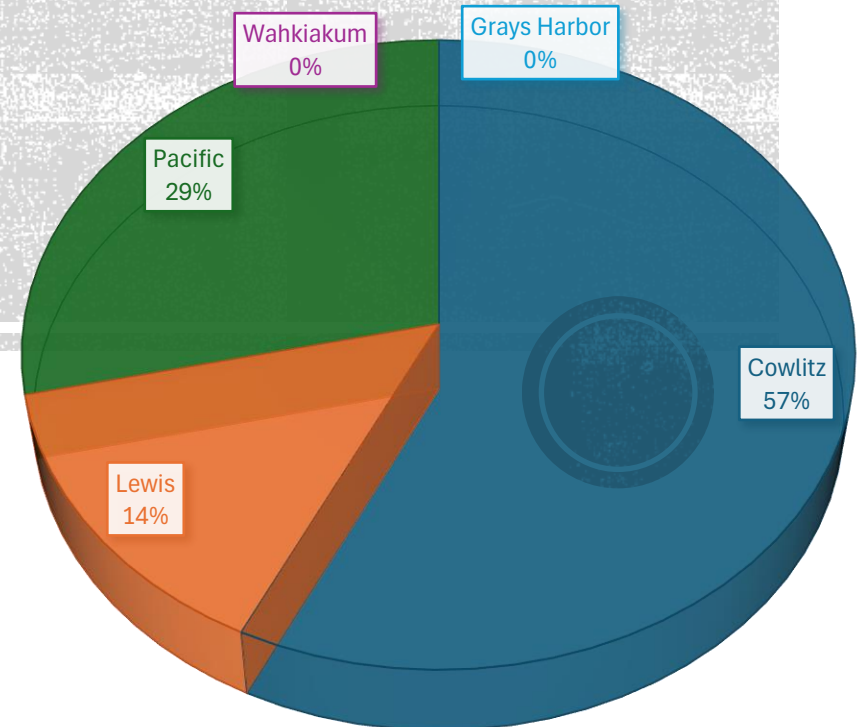
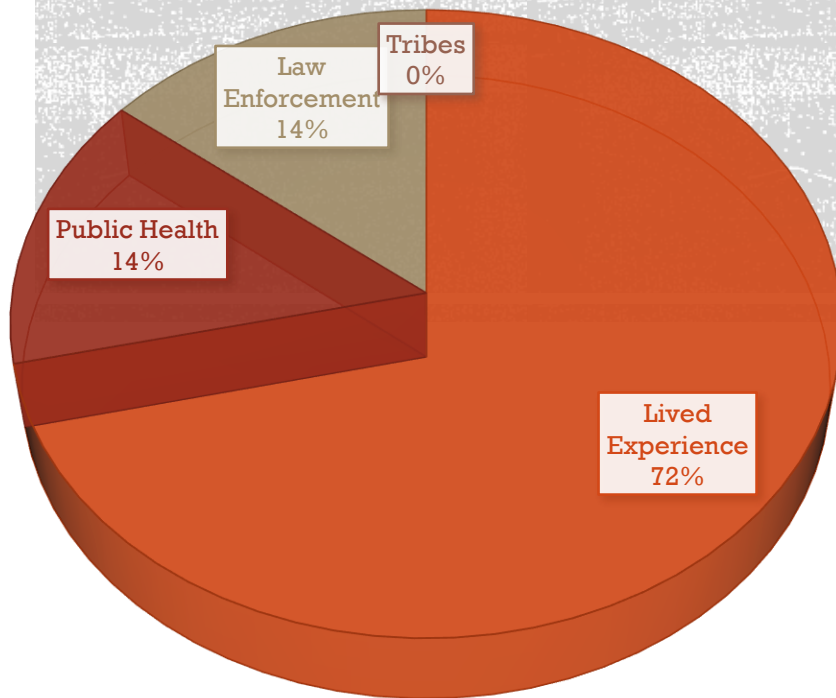

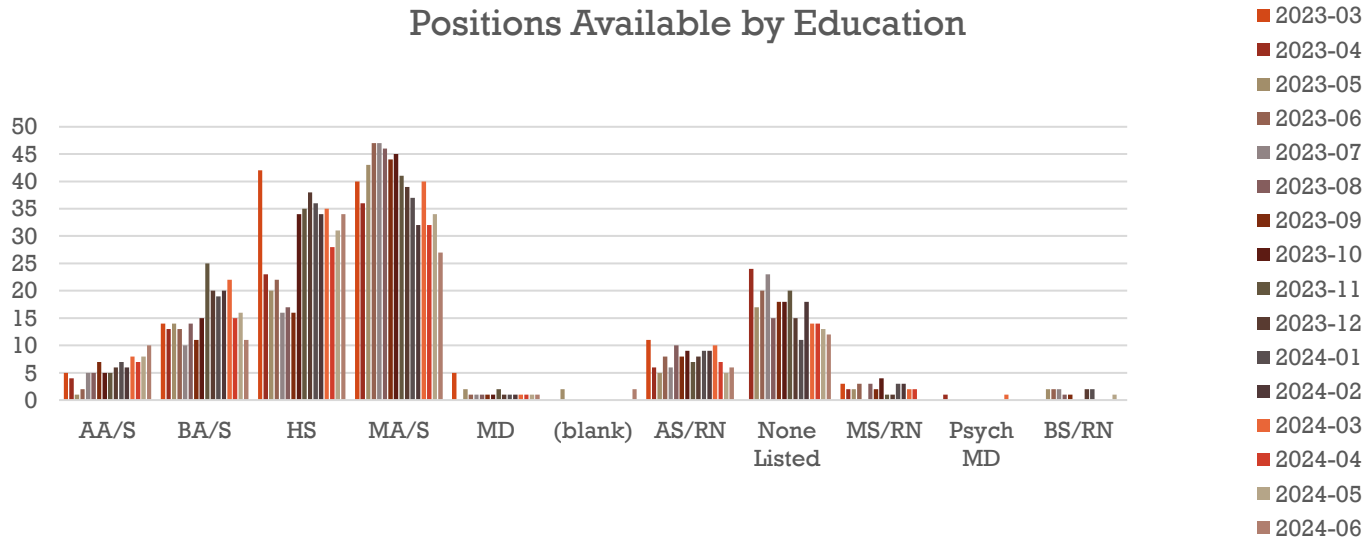

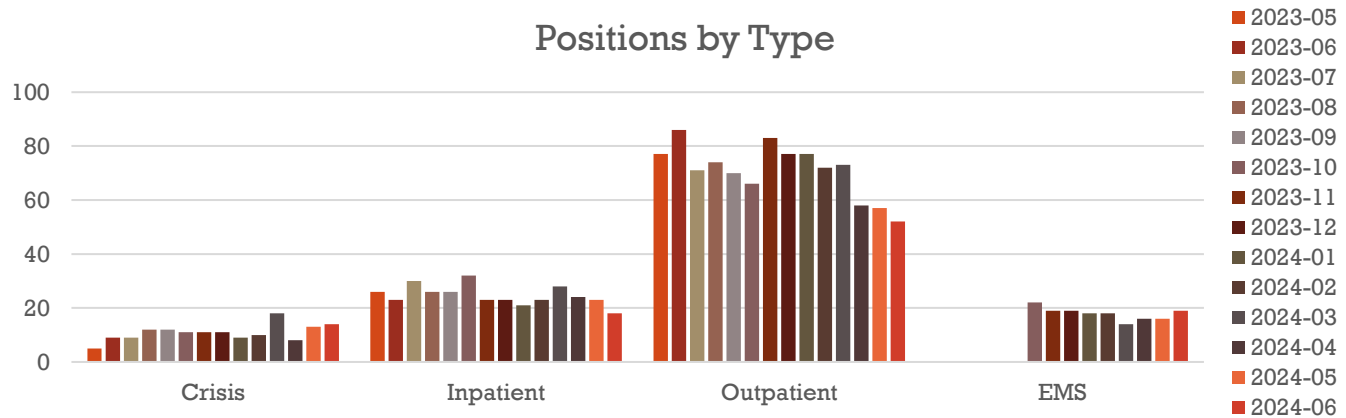
