6.	• Summary of the 2024 Legislative Session	11:15pam	Michael Langer,	Discussion: New Budget Items: 1915i State Plan: additional funds for long term care specifically for adults. • Thomas Jackson: Does this also extend the stay for behavioral health facilities past 28? • Teresa Claycamp: No, this is not for treatment facilities but more for DSHS Aging Long Term Services so if someone in assisted living or adult family home needs additional supports, this provides that support. Olympic Heritage Behavioral Health: There is currently a provider survey open until 5/20/2024 to share input on what services are most needed. • Discussion around Olympic Heritage Behavioral Health only serving King County vs State. • Most of the current residents at Olympic Heritage were pulled from Western state Hospital so originally came from across the state. • 70 beds are currently through DSHS but 40 beds will be community operated beds contracted through a provider. • Nathan Lusk will send link to the Olympic Heritage Survey with meeting notes.
