On May 10, 2023, the Washington State Health Care Authority received approval from the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) of the state's request for an amendment to the section 1115(a) demonstration, titled "Washington COVID-19 Public Health Emergency" section 1115(a) demonstration (Project Number 11-W-00345/0).
