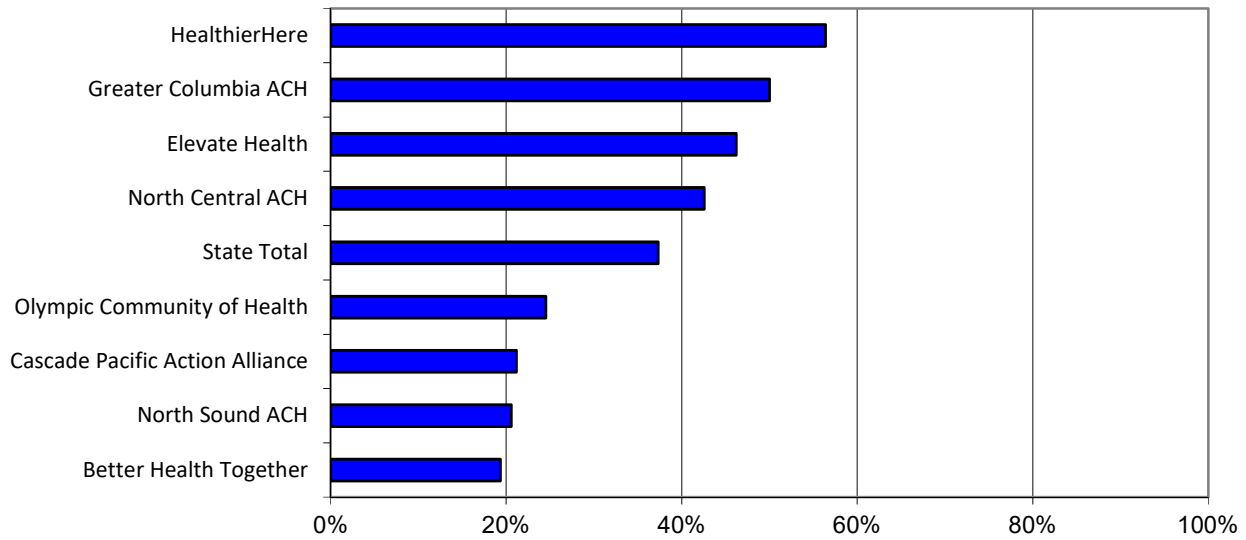

by Women with Medicaid-Paid Maternity Care Who Delivered in 2020**

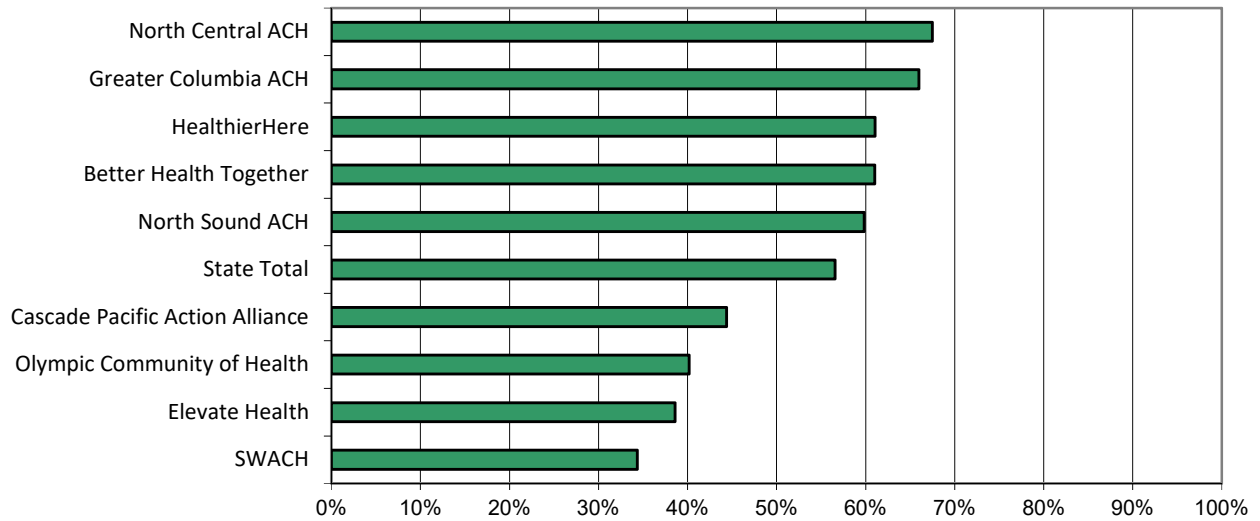

Pregnant, Medicaid-eligible women may receive maternity support services through the First Steps Program. For this analysis, receipt of maternity support services includes paid maternity-related services received in the 270 days prior to delivery or up to 90 days after delivery. Women who received only childcare visit authorizations or childbirth/parenting education are not included among women receiving services. As of 2014, records do not include out-of-state deliveries to Washington residents because birth certificates for states other than Washington were not available for record linkage. State Total includes a small number of women for whom residence ACH could not be determined.
