**Exit Outcomes Among PCAP Clients: Washington State PCAP**

PCAP clients exit the program three years after their PCAP enrollment. These tables present PCAP exit information over the past 6 years, i.e., data for clients exiting July 2017–June 2023, including 47 "early exits" whose projected three-year exit dates were between April 2023 and December 2024.
