During the meeting, we began by reading the public participation slides to the group. We then introduced the SUDISA SharePoint page and Kelley Sandaker from HCA demonstrated how to use MURAL from the SUDISA SharePoint page. To ensure everyone had access, we shared the link for the Mural in the chat.

On the Mural, we implemented a color-coded system.

- Yellow-Sticks represented desired outcomes.
- Green-Barrier
- Blue-Sticks represented existing solutions,
- Pink-Sticks represented recommended solutions.

The team divided the yellow stick notes into three different groups:

- Goal 1- To broaden the workforce capable of administering SUD assessments.
- Goal 2- To make the process as brief, low-barrier, and person-centered as possible to initiate care.
- Third group was for any other goals.

The committee instructed each member to select a yellow sticky note and provide a recommendation on a pink sticky note. Then, they placed these pink sticky notes next to the corresponding yellow sticky notes. In the last 45 minutes of the meeting, we dedicated our time to reviewing each of the pink sticky notes that we had created. However, there were six yellow stick notes that did not have a corresponding pink stick note. To address this, we brainstormed as a group and typed out the remaining six pink stick notes.

This meeting was not recorded. We have made efforts in the future to ensure recording will always happen.
