			<p>Redefine recovery support services to include harm reduction services.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Sarah MK: “redefining for the purposes of advocating for policy change” - Why do we want to redefine? <p>Added: Establish uniform standard requirements (counties vary, currently)</p> <p><u>Ongoing Info/Communication Issue:</u> Added under “Shortening process for desired services.”</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Residential bed - Lack of 24/7 bed ED to detox - Transportation/coordination <p>Added under “Easy to follow-up on referrals.”</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Referral as barrier - Direct access to treatment - Clarification - Education for providers re SUD services - Busy schedules for staff/quick glance info <p>Added: People getting connected w/ supports in the moment (especially w/ outreach)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - No comments stated. <p>Beth Myers: Evergreen & Fairfax has beds 24/7.</p> <p>Dominique: Referral based w/o assistance. Issue when patient is in crisis/unrealistic expectations.</p> <p>Domique: Moving away from the idea of referral. Referral is “band aid”.</p> <p>Beth Myers: Time limited to learn. Important to continuously speak w/ providers.</p> <p>Added under “Facility Closing”</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Lack of services provided. - Lack of staffing - Ability to bill insurance. <p>Tony: Housing admission requirements tied to screening process. What sort of screening processes are required?</p>
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			<p>Beth Myers: Issues she faces—follow up for people. Not punishing people for missing appointments is harm reduction principle.</p> <p>Alicia E: Telehealth in WA. Mobile units talking about hospitals?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Kelley: Reading it as cannot leave their household. Jails, home, unhoused area. - Meta: Unhoused piece (highlight). Mobility issues/no public transportation. Rural areas. Large number of people in this category. <p>Beth: ASAM requiring 2 assessments (first, short. Second, long term planning assessment). Insurance and policy—long transition to implement these changes.</p> <p>Theresa: notes her experience, agency she worked for if assessment was not up to WAC standards, they were accountable to redo. Concern: retriggering for patients having to go through the process again.</p>
