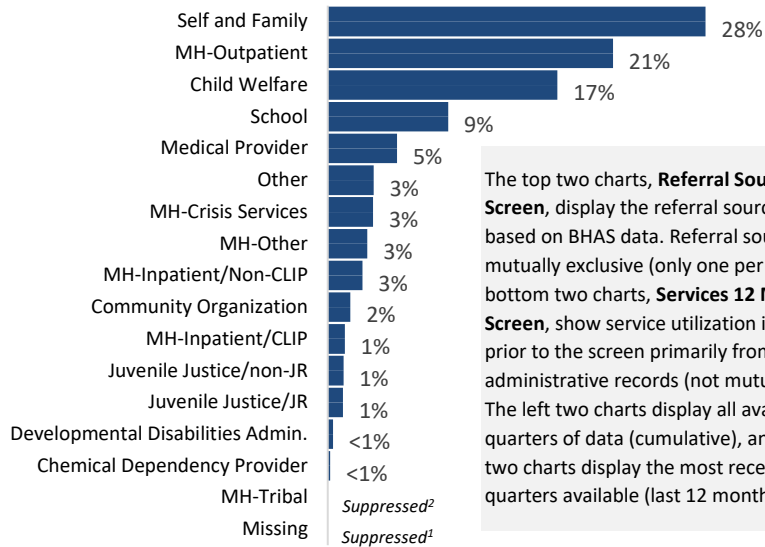

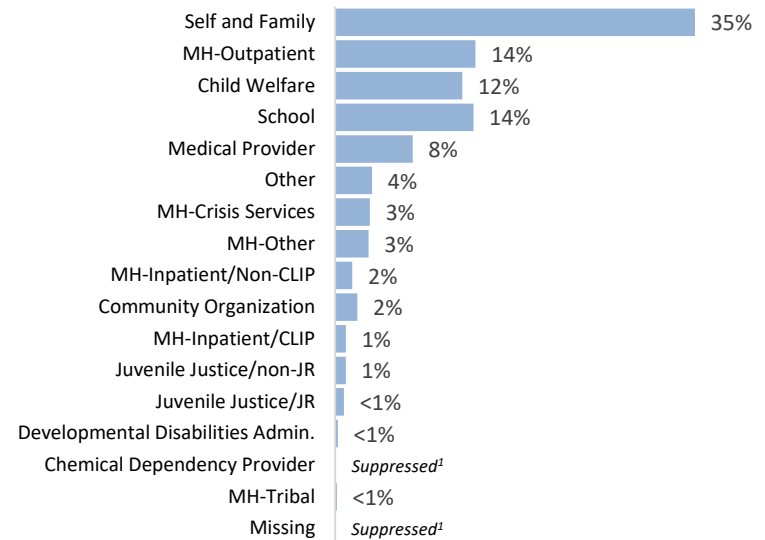

The bottom two charts, **Services 12 Months Before Screen**, show service utilization in the year prior to the screen primarily from administrative records (not mutually exclusive). The left two charts display all available quarters of data (cumulative), and the right two charts display the most recent four quarters available (last 12 months).

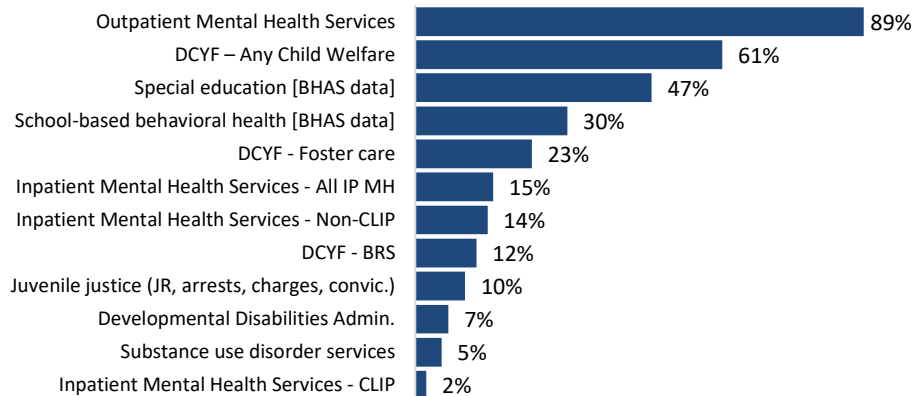
LAST 12 MONTHS July 2023 - June 2024



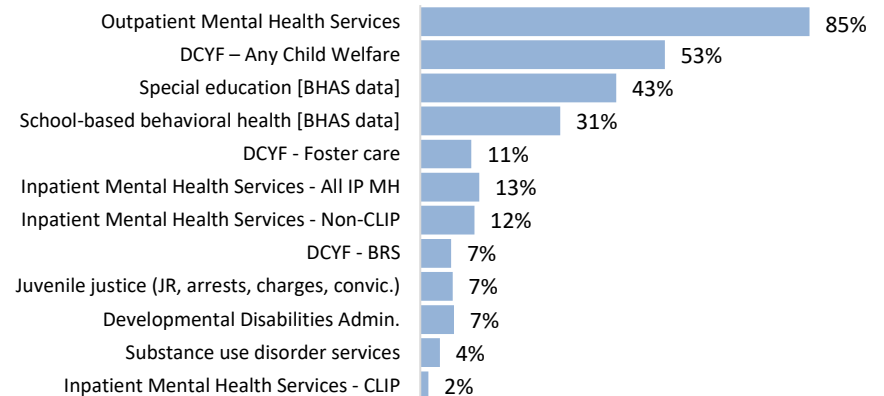

LAST 12 MONTHS April 2023 - March 2024

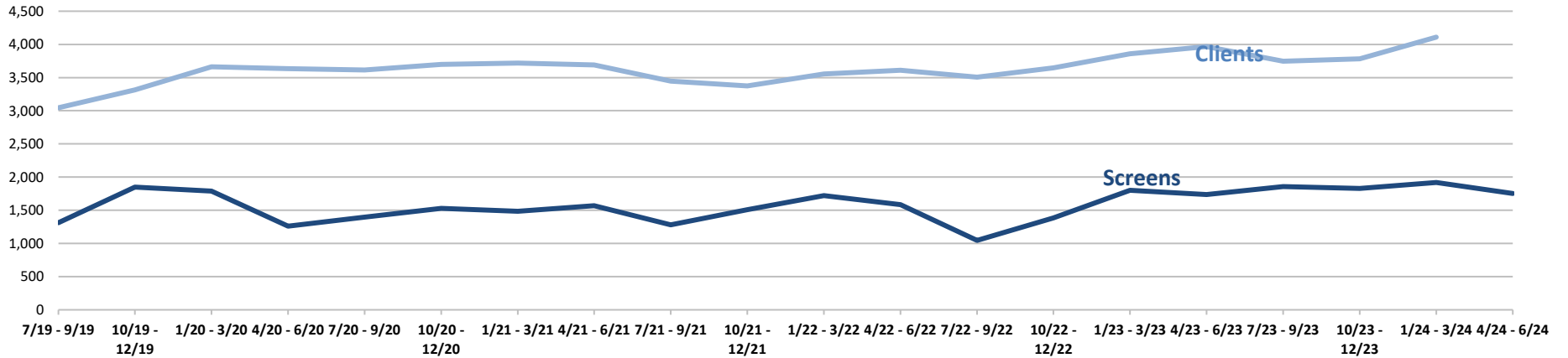
